### **Program Benefits:**

\$9.95 a month

No deposits, no contracts, no social security number required

Free Installation, free wifi modem rental

### **Eligibility:**

Have a K-12 student in household

Are a new Cox Internet customer

Household participates in government assistance programs:

 National School Lunch Program, Head Start, SNAP, TANF, WIC, LIHEAP, or live in public housing



### **COVID-19** Response

Free service for two months for new Connect2Compete customers who sign up by December 31, 2020

Cox outdoor Wifi Hotspots open to keep public connected

Suspending late fees for customers who express inability to pay

- Provide list of addresses
- School Portal (Phase 1) targeting release first week of August

- Families agree to subsidy and sign-up for service (if applicable)
- Self-Install kit
- Avoid Downgrades
- Parent Portal targeting release first week of August





# Mesa Public Schools Internet Accessibility

- June 2020 Technology Survey
  - 7% of students do not have reliable internet access (3,500/43,800)
- Principals identify one person from campus to be technology lead part of Family Support Network
  - 98 "tech leads" continue to support internet accessibility on campuses
- <u>Technology Leads</u>
  - 1st try to get family to sign up for Cox Connect2Compete; Cox provided training and resources to streamline process
  - 2nd option check out AT&T hotspot

### **Technology Leads:**

Worked with staff and families to identify internet needs

Supported families with signing them up for Cox or checking out a AT&T hotspot

Supported families and teachers with other technology questions



# **Tolleson Elementary S.D. Internet Accessibility**

#### Context

4 schools (2 schools in Tolleson and 2 in Phoenix) 3,000 treasures 85% free/reduced lunch

#### Survey

10% of families indicated no internet connectivity
