

LRE Categories

Attending a Regular Education Classroom (more than 50% non-disabled children)

PA1

AT LEAST 10 hours per week; receiving majority of special education and related services in REGULAR EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAM.

PA2

AT LEAST 10 hours per week; receiving majority of special education and related services in SOME OTHER LOCATION.

PB1

LESS THAN 10 hours per week; receiving majority of special education and related services in REGULAR EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAM.

PB2

LESS THAN 10 hours per week; receiving majority of special education and related services in SOME OTHER LOCATION

Attending a special education program only (less than 50% non-disabled children)

PD

Separate Class

Attends a special education program in a class intended primarily for children with disabilities

PE

Separate School

Receives all special education and related services in public or private day schools designed specifically for children with disabilities.

PG

Residential Facility

Receives all special education and related services in public or private residential schools or residential medical facilities on an inpatient basis.

Not attending a regular or special education classroom

PH1

Home AT LEAST 360 minutes per week.

Receives all special education and related services in the principal residence of the child's family or caregiver and attended neither a regular early childhood program nor a special education program provided in a separate class, separate school, or residential facility.

PH2

Home LESS THAN 360 minutes per week.

Receives all special education and related services in the principal residence of the child's family or caregiver and attended neither a regular early childhood program nor a special education program provided in a separate class, separate school, or residential facility.

PS

Service Provider Location or some other location that is not in any other category for less than 360 minutes per week.

Receives all special education and related services from a service provider and who attended neither a regular early childhood program nor a special education program. This includes services received at a private clinician's office; clinician's office located in a school building; or hospital facility on an outpatient basis.
