Acceleration Academies Update



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Purpose

On November 10, 2020, the Governor's Office and the Arizona Department of Education (ADE) announced \$19 million to help Arizona students most impacted by the COVID pandemic. The funding supports a program called the Acceleration Academies and comes from the Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) Fund as part of the CARES Act.

Indicators for Eligibility

Eligibility for the Acceleration Academies was determined using multiple factors, including:

- Free and Reduced Lunch applications
- Not Proficient AzMERIT ELA and Math scores
- Unemployment claims in corresponding zip codes
- COVID cases in corresponding zip codes
- No access to computer in corresponding zip codes
- No access to internet in corresponding zip codes

Base Funding:

183 schools with 36+ pts receive a \$75,000 base award

Impact Funding:

37 of the 183 schools have a score of 41+, demonstrating more need. Additional \$100,000

Enrollment Funding:

Of the 37 most impacted schools, 10 have 500+ students. Additional \$157,500

Proposed Funding Formula- Three Components

1. Base Funding:

√Score of 36 or greater

2. Impact Funding:

√Score of 41 or greater

3. Enrollment Funding:

✓ Student population of 500 or greater

Funding Components Rationale:

> Base Funding:

> Every school will need a base level of aide in order to effectively provide evidence-based interventions

> Impact Funding:

- Even with our cut score of 36 points, some schools were impacted significantly more than others
- These schools tend to be historically under-resourced and will need more funding in order to make an impact

> Enrollment Funding:

- Schools with more than 500 students will need additional funding to meet the needs of all of their students
- Why not a per pupil formula?
 - Smaller schools would have received far less than would have allowed them to make an impact
 - > There would be a large disparity of the total amounts of the awards


Calculation Process:

- > Base Funding: 183 schools
 - > Every school will need at least \$75,000 to implement enough evidence-based interventions to have an impact
 - > This is a total of \$13,725,000
- > Impact Funding: 37 schools
 - > Our 37 highest impacted schools will receive an additional \$100,000 for a total of \$175,000
 - > This is an additional total \$4,625,000
- > Enrollment Funding: 10 schools
 - ➤ Our 10 highest impacted schools with 500 or more students will receive an additional \$157,500 for a total of \$332,500
 - > This is an additional total \$1,650,000

Grand Total: \$19,000,000




