Offered as a special: 30 minute class rotations, 8 rotations/day

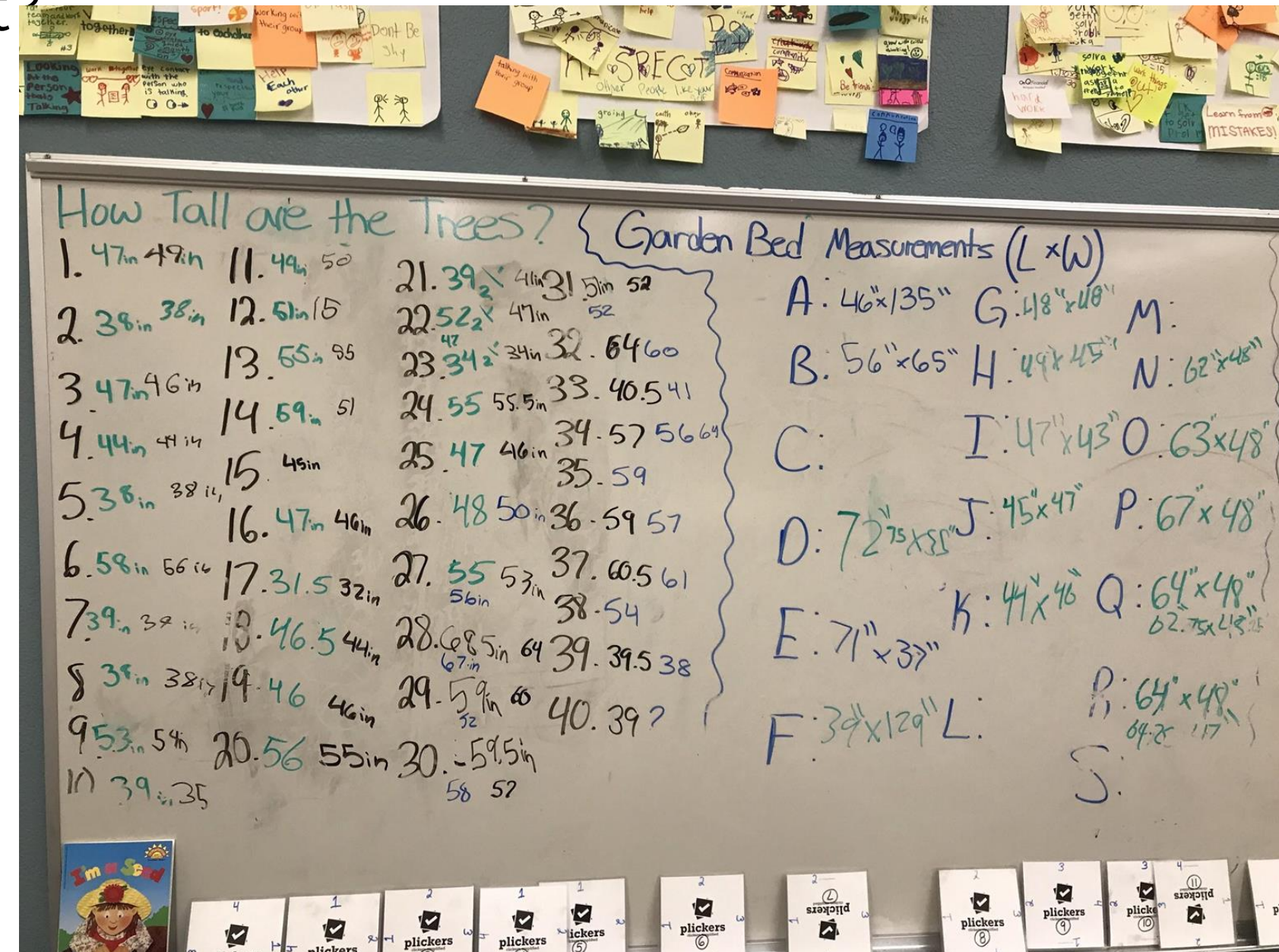
Student Led

- It all started with trees...

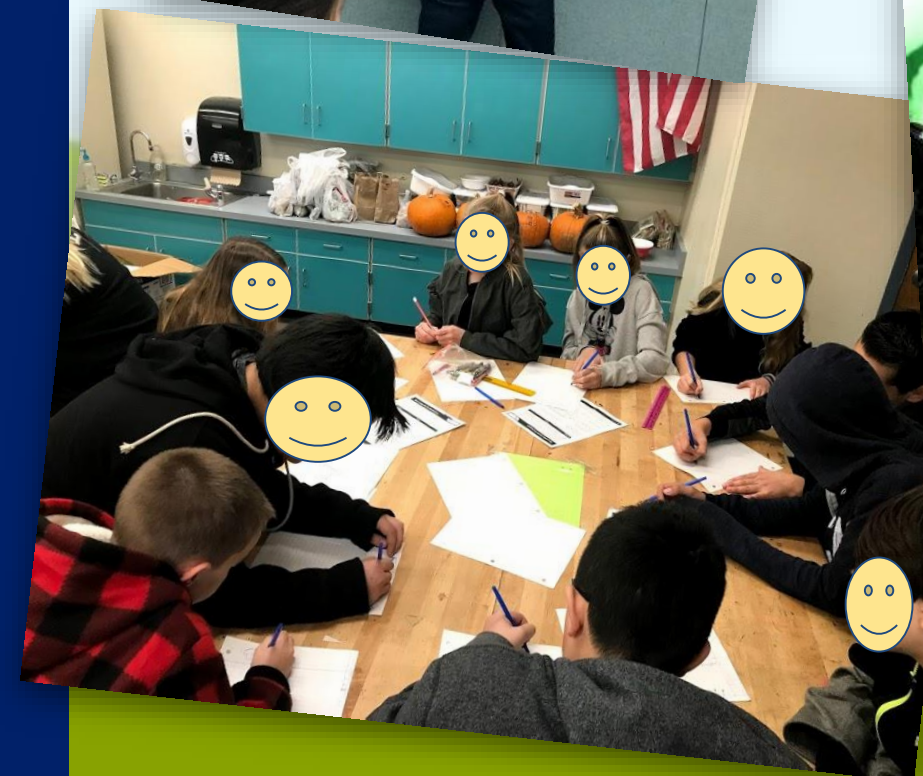
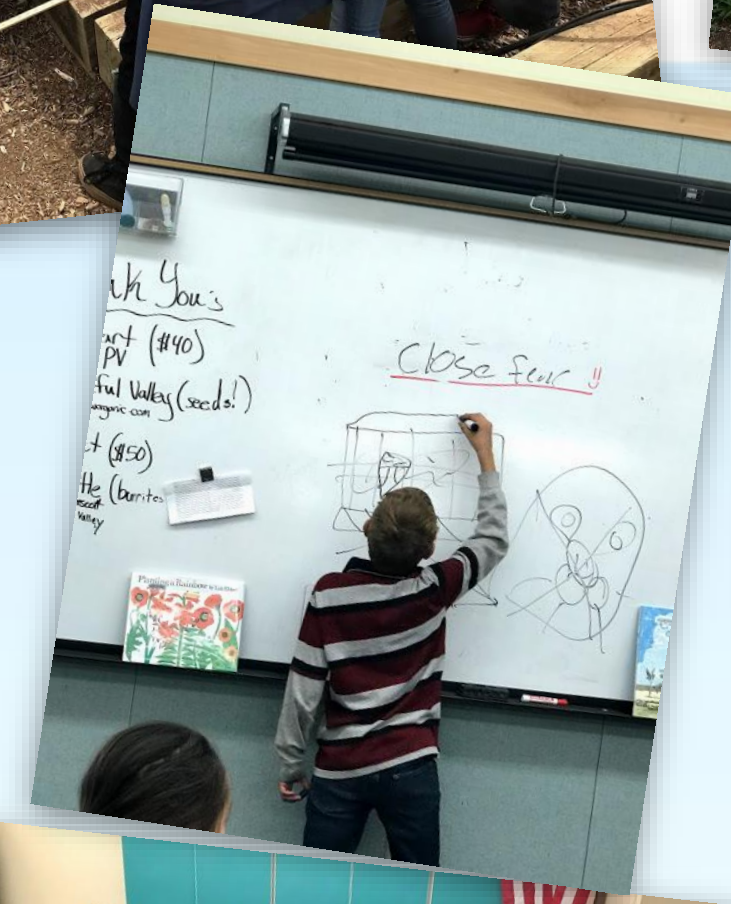


Problem-Based Learning

- What do we need for our garden to be successful and what will it cost?



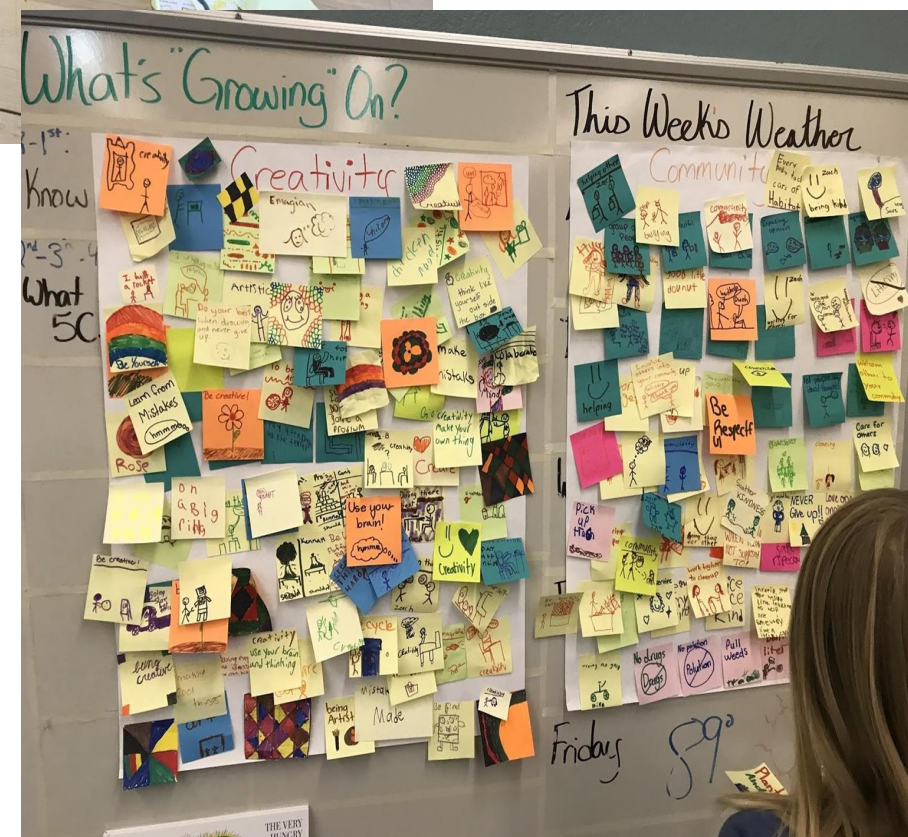
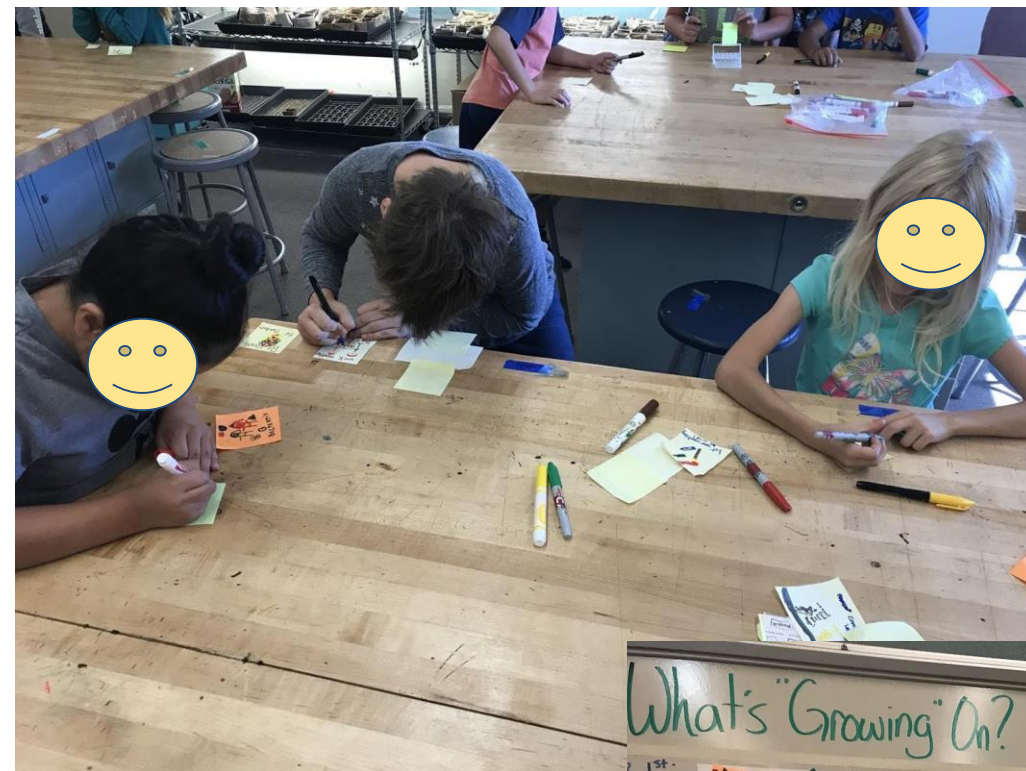

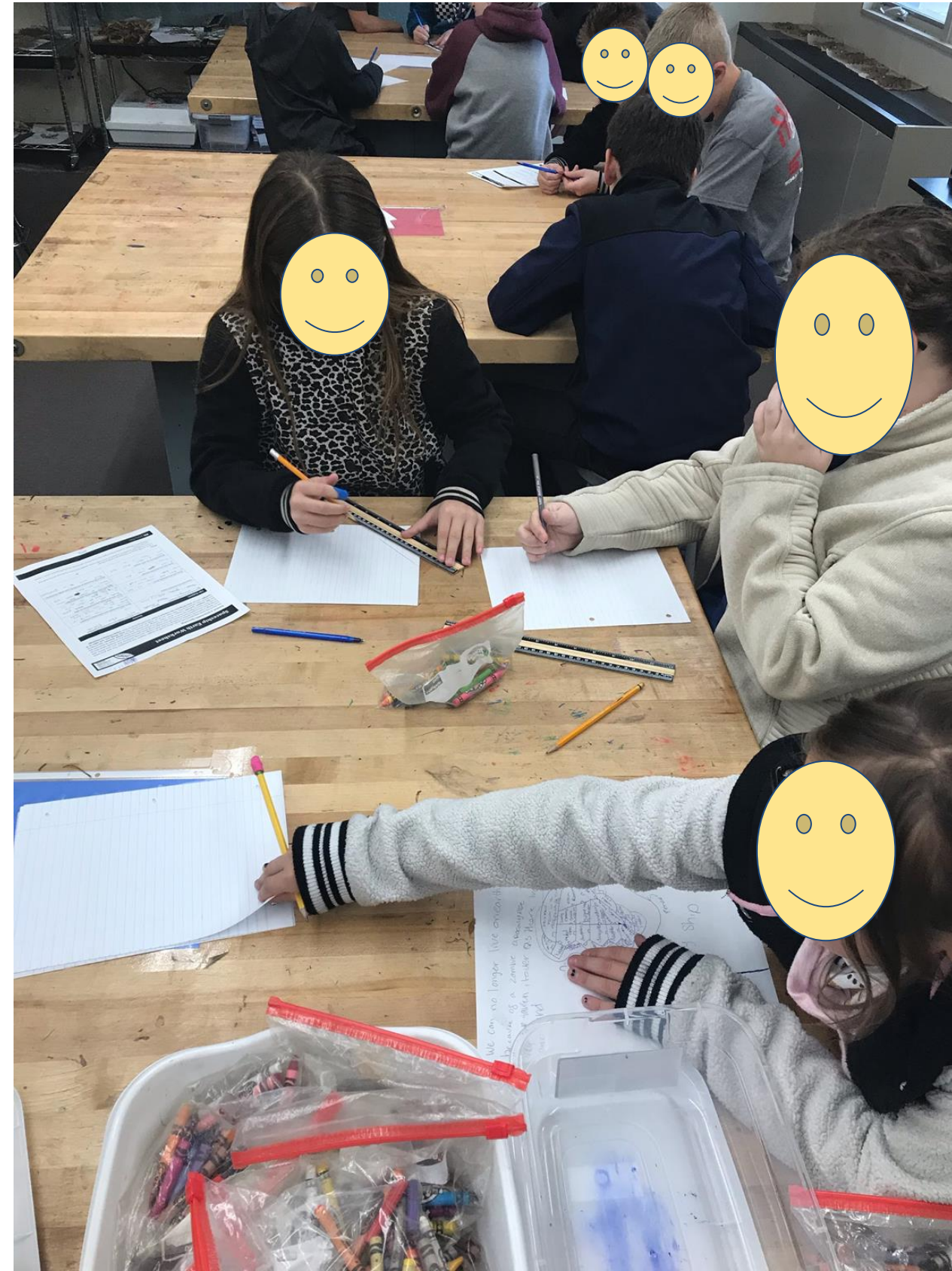
