

# **Integrity Error -40080**

### **Error Message:**

SPED Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) is not allowed at the site on the next in-session day after Exit Code SPED01 is reported.

### **Description:**

When a student SPED Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) is reported with SPED01 Exit Code (Transferred to Regular Education), there must be continuing enrollment at that site on the next in-session day with no SPED LRE reported.

### **Example:**

Is the student enrolled at the same site the next insession day?

Is the student in SPED the next insession day at the

same site?

Students must continue enrollment at the same site the next in-session day after SPED is exited with SPED01 (Transferred to Regular Education).

Students may not continue SPED services at the same site the next in-session day after SPED is exited with SPED01 (Transferred to Regular Education). NOTE: This applies to the next in-session day only.

#### **Troubleshooting:**

- Verify the LRE Exit Reason is accurate.
- Verify the student's enrollment at the site includes the next in-session day according to the calendar.
- Verify there is no LRE reported at that site the next in-session day according to the calendar. NOTE: This applies to the next in-session day only.
- Verify the reported calendar is passing integrity.
- This rule will not apply for entities without calendars.
- If the student is a preschooler who no longer qualifies for Special Education and does not continue at the site for general education due to parental decision, use exit code SPED10.
- Once corrected, allow integrity to run overnight to see if student is passing integrity on SPED72 report.
