

Integrity Error -40082

Error Message:

SPED Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) with Exit Code SPED03 can only be reported for student age greater than or equal to 21. No SPED LREs are allowed for the site after Exit Code SPED03 is reported.

Description:

When a student SPED Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) is reported with SPED03 Exit Code (Reached Maximum Age), the student's age must be equal to or greater than 21 based on the exit date, with no follow up SPED LRE at that site.

Example:

- SPED
 - LRE Exit Date
 - LRE Exit Reason
- Student
 - Birthdate

-40082 Is the student 21 years old or older?



Are there any SPED LREs at the site after the SPED03 exit?

Student must be 21yrs old or older on the Exit Date if the SPED03 exit code is reported.

Students reported with SPED03 no longer qualify for Special Education and cannot be reported as SPED after a SPED03 exit.

Troubleshooting:

- Verify the LRE Exit Reason is accurate.
- Verify the students age is 21 or older based on the LRE Exit Date.
- Verify there is not a SPED LRE reported at the site after the SPED03 Exit Code is used.
- SPED03 cannot be used for Preschool students. While a student can age out of PS
 enrollment, they cannot age out of SPED eligibility at that age.
- Once corrected, allow integrity to run overnight to see if student is passing integrity on SPED72 report.
