## Where we are today

- Arizona's Board of Education (August 21, 2020) decided to utilize authority allowed in waiver response for AIMS and AIM A Science
- Field tests for AzSCI and Science Alternate
   Assessment will have all eligible students
   participate. These tests will be shortened versions
   (of typical operational length)
- The current AZELLA Reassessment Test and AzM2
  will be shortened as well as all embedded field test
  items have been removed from the 2020-2021 tests

Update: AzM2 Test window has been extended for both online and paper (See Assessment Overview 2020 and Beyond document)

Update: AZELLA Reassessment Test Window has been extended: February 1, 2021 through May 21, 2021

Update: AZELLA Stand-Alone Field Test has been postponed to Fall 2021

Update: ADE Assessment Team is developing a survey for AzM2 Test Administrators and Administrators.

- Its purpose will be to provide context for assessment results
- ADE as a data point to understand impact on educators and students during the pandemic

## **State and Federal Accountability**

State School Letter Grades (A - F) are mandated by State Law

There are no State Waivers from State Accountability. It requires State Legislative action

**UPDATE**: ADE is in the process of submitting a waiver for Federal Accountability to postpone CSI low achievement and (a) TSI\* school identification until 2021-2022; these schools are identified every three years

Accountability Team working with State Board of Education, the ATAC, AOI-TAC, and the AATC looking into the impact of COVID on all of the variables and components of A-F

March 3rd and March 24<sup>th</sup>

Deadline to submit accommodations - January 12th

Note: 21,000 Students were administered ACT in our High Schools in October


