ADE/CTE Approved Professional Development for Certification Credit Hours and CTE Professional Development Hours for Continuing Education and Recertification Credit

ADE/CTE Approved Professional Development Certification Credit Hours (can equal to college credit hours)

- ADE/CTE approved PD provided by LEAs, CTE partners, or postsecondary college credit institutions
- 15 clock hours* of ADE/CTE approved PD certification credit equals 1 semester hour of college credit...
 - * Clock hours are the time spent in a classroom or other learning environment.
- Only ADE/CTE approved professional development issuing the certificate shown below can be used for CTE certification credit.

Note: ADE/CTE Approved Professional Development Certification Credit can be applied to a Standard CTE K-12 Certificate or to remove deficiencies from a Standard CTE teaching certificate after August 9, 2017 under Options A, B, C, D or E in all CTE Certification areas.

CTE Professional Development Hours for Continuing Education and Recertification Credit

- PD provided to CTE teachers by local education agencies (LEAs) and entities (i.e., CTE Program Specialists, CTSOs, Conferences, Trainings, Meetings, etc.) for the purpose of continuing education and recertification.
- PD hours are shown on PD Certificates of Attendance.
- PD hours are nontransferable to college credit.
