

### **Educator Peer Support Program**







- Purpose is to provide prompt consultation and short-term support to teachers and administrators through trained peer coaches
- Referral for professional support as needed
  - Acute distress, grief, substance use, burnout, family concerns
- Training and case management provided by contracted mental health care agency
- Timeline
  - Recruitment and training of peer coaches in February/March
  - Begin services mid-March
