FY21 ADM vs FY20 ADM

| | FY 2021 (2/2/2021) | FY 2020 (2/2/2020) | FY 2020 Final |
|-------------|-----------------------|-----------------------|------------------|
| Regular ADM | 1,075,877 | 1,115,967 | 1,117,521 |
| SPED ADM | 129,646 | 132,760 | 134,199 |
| ELL ADM | 69,253 | 69,303 | 69,927 |



FY21 ADM vs FY20 ADM

| | % Change Compared to 2/2/2020 | % Change Compared to Final FY 20 |
|-------------|-------------------------------------|--|
| Regular ADM | - 3.6 % | -3.7% |
| SPED ADM | -2.3% | -3.4% |
| ELL ADM | -0.1% | -1.0% |



Distance Learning Updates

- Distance learning reports submitted for the first 40 days have been archived
- It is now possible to upload a new distance learning report for the entire school year
- Adjustment amounts will be updated before the 5/1 payment for any DL reports submitted by 4/16
- All LEAs must submit final reports by 5/14

Aggregate Expenditures Limit

 ARS <u>15-911</u> requires an annual report by <u>11/1</u> on aggregate expenditures of local revenue as defined in the <u>Arizona Constitution</u>.

 \$138 million over the limit in November based on original budgets and budget revisions submitted on or before 10/22

• Required to calculate the amount by which districts must reduced spending in the event the Legislature does not authorize excess by 3/5



Aggregate Expenditures Limit

- School Finance updated the calculation in February
- Spending was \$283M lower considering budget revisions submitted between 10/22 and 2/17
 - No longer exceeds the limit
- BUDG-AGD reports published on the School Finance website reflect the updated numbers



Results-Based Funding

- Second payment (40%) will be paid in early May
- Awards based on FY 2019 assessment results and poverty measures
 - Laws 2020, Chapter 49
- Allocations are posted on the School Finance website
 - FY2021 Results-Based Funding
