Only 2.25 cups fruit served, when 4 cups made to ensure it doesn't continue needed to meet weekly meal pattern requirement. This was not a repeat meal pattern finding and did not contribute towards fiscal action calculations.
- 5 Quantities observed during the review period did not Discussed how current system meet minimum amounts required by the lunch meal pattern. Specifically, weekly grain requirement was not met. Only 6.25 oz.eq. grain was served, when 6.5 made to ensure it doesn't continue oz.eq. grain needed to meet weekly meal pattern requirement. This was not a repeat meal pattern finding and did not contribute towards fiscal action calculations.
