

Gold	60% or + Arts Enrollment
Silver	50 – 59% Arts Enrollment
Bronze	40 – 49% Arts Enrollment
Developing	Less than 40% Arts Enrollment

Example: **DEVELOPING** Rating – only 39% Arts Enrollment




Example: **GOLD** Rating – 76% Arts Enrollment



Example: **GOLD** Rating – categories add up to 200% - students are all enrolled in music AND visual arts



Example: **SILVER** Rating - Categories add up to 110% - most students only take one artistic discipline



Gold	Grew in all Artistic Disciplines offered or maintained 100% enrollment	
Silver	Grew in most artistic disciplines offered and maintained at less than 100% in all	
	others (no declining enrollments)	
Bronze	Enrollment declined in some but not all offered arts disciplines.	
Developing	Declined enrollment in all offered artistic disciplines.	

Example: GOLD Rating – school grew music enrollment and maintained 100% Visual Arts enrollment.



Example: GOLD Rating – enrollment grew in all artistic disciplines.




Example: SILVER Rating – enrollment grew in two disciplines and maintained at less than 100% in two



Example: BRONZE Rating – enrollment maintained in Visual Arts but dropped in Music.






#### **HOW TO:**

- Open the <u>Exemplary Arts Schools Ratings</u> spreadsheet.
- Open the Arts Education Census Explorer.
- Click 'School Profile', then use the filter button to find select the county/school district/school:
