Program Description, Industry Credentials, Coherent Sequence, and Teacher Certification Requirements

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The **Air Transportation** instructional program prepares individuals to apply technical knowledge and skills to the flying and/or navigation of fixed wing aircraft. This program includes instruction in principles of aircraft design and performance, aircraft flight systems and controls, flight crew operations and procedures, radio communications, navigation procedures and systems, airways safety and traffic regulations, and governmental rules and regulations pertaining to piloting aircraft.

The **Air Transportation** program is delivered as a coherent sequence of courses designed to offer students knowledge and skills that meet the needs of the workplace. The Professional Skills developed by business and industry leaders across Arizona are integrated throughout the program. **Air Transportation** students develop leadership, social, civic, and career skills through participation in the state-recognized Career and Technical Student Organization, SkillsUSA.

The **Air Transportation** instructional program prepares students for entry-level employment, further training, and/or postsecondary education for these and other occupations: Private Pilot, Copilots, and Unmanned Aircraft

 - Air Transportation 36.0202.80 (Cooperative Ed.) requires a CTE Teacher to be appropriately certified for the program and to have a Cooperative Education Endorsement (CEN).
