Program Description, Industry Credentials, Coherent Sequence, and Teacher Certification Requirements

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The **Fire Service** program focuses on the principles, theory, and practices associated with the management of fire operations, firefighting services, and community fire issues. The **Fire Service** program includes instruction in fire protection history and theory, incident command leadership, administration of public fire organizations, labor relations, emergency medical services management, fire emergency response strategies and mitigation, legal and regulatory responsibilities, budgeting, public relations, and organizational leadership.

The **Fire Service** program is delivered as a coherent sequence of courses designed to offer students knowledge and skills that meet the needs of the workplace. The Professional Skills developed by business and industry leaders across Arizona are integrated throughout the program. **Fire Service** students develop leadership, social, civic, and career skills through participation in the state-recognized Career and Technical Student Organization, SkillsUSA.

The **Fire Service** instructional program prepares students for entry-level employment, further training, and/or postsecondary education for these and other occupations: Firefighter, Wildlife Firefighter, and EMT.

- Fire Service 43.0202.70 may be a part of the sequence and requires a CTE Teacher to have the Cooperative Education Endorsement (CEN).
 - Fire Service 43.0202.75 **does not** require a CTE Teacher to have a Cooperative Education Endorsement (CEN).
 - Fire Service 43.0202.80 requires a CTE Teacher to be appropriately certified for the program and to have a Cooperative Education Endorsement (CEN).
