Specifically, whole-grain rich weekly requirement was not met during breakfast or lunch. SFA served the following products that are not WG-rich: cereal at breakfast and spaghetti noodles at lunch.

Specifically, on 1/19/21 only 1.25 oz.eq. grain was served when 2 oz.eq. grain is needed to meet daily 9-12 meal pattern requirements. This was determined to be a repeat finding from cycle two and contributed toward fiscal action calculations.

Meal pattern two and contributed towards fiscal action calculations.
- The following vegetable subgroup was not offered during the review period: dark green. This was not a repeat finding and did not contribute towards fiscal action calculations.
