2 The Multiple Days Meal Distribution Plan was not submitted to ADE prior to distributing meals for multiple days. Multiple Days Meal Distribution Plan waiver was submitted on 3/8/21 and indicated a multiple meal distribution start date of 9/8/20. Additionally, submitted waiver indicates the only meal service model utilized is pickup. However, in addition to a pickup service model, SFA also utilizes a USDA has instructed ADE to assess home delivery service model.

Discussed the non-congregate feeding, meal times and parent/guardian pickup waivers in bulk and to distribute meals for multiple days for pickup or delivery. To distribute meals for multiple days, the SFA's capacity to execute such an approach effectively. Additionally, discussed ADE has created a Multiple Days Meal Distribution Plan Form for SFAs to provide details on how the distribution plan will be executed.

## Quantities observed during the review period, and during the week of the day of review, did not meet minimum amounts required by the lunch meal

pattern. Weekly minimum grain requirement was not made to ensure it doesn't continue met. Only 7.5 oz.eq. grain served, when 8 oz.eq. grain needed to meet weekly meal pattern requirement.

Specifically, meat/meat alternate not present or insufficient quantity on the following days: meatballs served on 2/23 and 3/9; ham served on 2/25 and 3/11; and turkey served on 2/26 and 3/12.

Discussed that ADE is permitted to by the SFA providing the meals due to shortages and/or supply chain issues. SFAs must maintain daily records of meals with meal pattern deficiencies by component, per meal service.
