Quantities observed during the review period did not meet minimum amounts required by the to happen and potential changes that could be changes that have been made to ensure that meal pattern. Specifically, weekly dark green vegetable quantities were not met during the week of review (February 1-5, 2021) at lunch. This was not a repeat finding from cycle two and requirements for the National School Lunch did not contribute toward fiscal action calculations.

weekly dark green vegetable quantities at lunch meet minimum amounts required by the meal pattern. Additionally, the certificate of completion of Using Appropriate Serving Utensils must be submitted.

During the week of review, all grains served at breakfast and lunch were not whole grain-rich. Specifically, the blueberry muffin served at breakfast on 2/1/21, the French toast served at breakfast on 2/2/21, the cornbread served at lunch on 2/3/21, and the breadstick served at lunch on 2/5/21 were not whole grain-rich. The SFA attributed this to the court ruling; however, a meal pattern waiver was not submitted.

During the day of review, all grains served at lunch were not whole grain-rich. Specifically, the USDA's Whole Grain Resource for the National that describes the justification for not serving garlic toast served on 3/17/21 was not whole grain-rich. The SFA attributed this to the court ruling; however, a meal pattern waiver was not submitted.

Fluid milk was not available in at least two varieties for each meal service. The SFA attributed this to the learning plan not allowing for milk choice at each meal service; however, a meal pattern waiver was not submitted.

Discussed variety requirement and feasible options for compliance (e.g., incorporating milk variety into mobile service or submitting a waiver). Allowable milk varieties are fat-free for the timeframe of mobile meal service. unflavored, fat-free flavored and 1% unflavored. Please note that repeated violations involving milk requirements may result in fiscal action and/or termination of performance-based reimbursement (extra 7 cents).

Please submit an SSO Meal Pattern Waiver to ADE that describes the justification for not offering two varieties of milk during breakfast and lunch

# **Counting & Claiming**

Separate meal counts were not taken per meal service. Specifically, breakfast and lunch counts were combined onto one count sheet.

Discussed that counting records for meals served must align to the meal service and the day the meal is intended to be consumed.
