Specifically, insufficient dark green vegetable changes that could be made to ensure subgroup quantities were served at lunch—only 1/4 cup dark green vegetable was served throughout the week when 1/2 cup vegetable is required. This was not a repeat finding from cycle two and did not contribute toward fiscal action calculations.

Specifically, insufficient daily meat/meat alternate quantities were served at lunch on 2/5/21 as the result of insufficient crediting documentation provided for the burrito. Advertising literature was provided, therefore the reviewer was unable to determine how much meat/meat alternate was served. This was not a repeat finding from cycle two and did not contribute toward fiscal action
