Breakfast quantities during the review period did not meet the minimum amounts required by the meal pattern. Specifically, at Chinle Junior High School on March 14, 2021, only 1/2 cup fruit was served and this did not meet the minimum daily requirement of 1 such as double checking the cup fruit. This resulted in only 6.5 cups of fruit offered production record to make sure all during the week, which does not meet the minimum weekly requirement of 7 cups of fruit. This was determined to not be a repeat finding from cycle two National School Breakfast Program and did not contribute toward fiscal action calculations.

Discussed how current system allowed for this to happen and potential changes that could be made to ensure it doesn't continue, items are served and recorded.
