### 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC Student Attendance Guidance



Requirement: All 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC student attendance is required to be entered into Student Information System (SIS) and uploaded to ADE via AzEDS.

Why: ADE uses this student data to report for schools in various ways, most extensively in the Annual Performance Report required federally each term.

#### Entering Data into your Student Information System (SIS)

This section gives general information about what data is required for entering 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC program attendance into your SIS.

Each SIS is structured differently to meet these 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC reporting requirements. For specific questions you may have to reference vendor guidance and documentation.

# Attendance Guidance

## Attendance Guidance - Highlights

- NEW- only one program name next year-
  - 21st CCLC
- NEW- Begin/End Times now required for each entry
- Likely multiple entries a day
- Report accurate to time attended
  - ADE will round

# Same vs. Changing

**Q: Can you clarify what is staying the same and what is changing?**

**A:**

# Extra Staff Time



**Q: Can I pay staff extra hours for this reporting?**

**A: Yes**

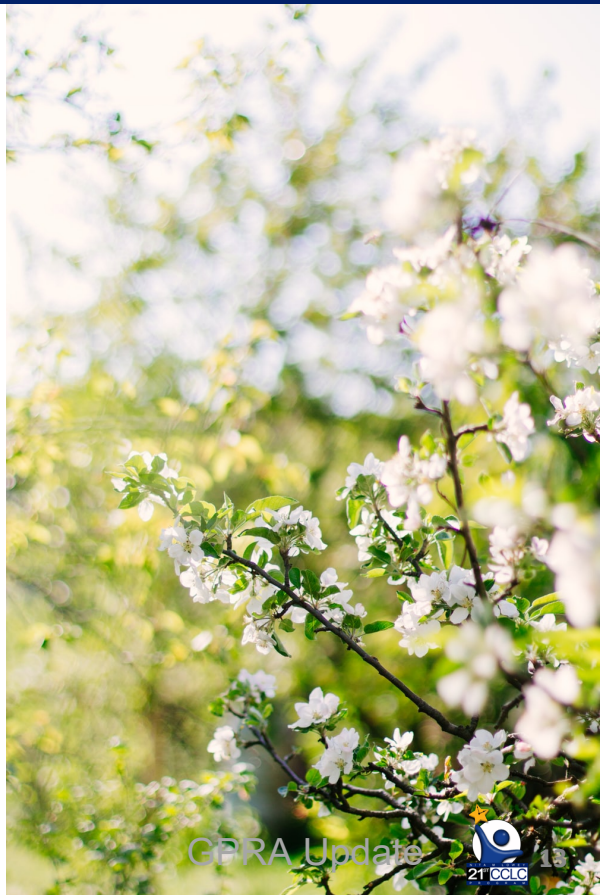
- Extra hours to existing staff
- Hire a new position. Data entry= clerical work.
- FY22 budget due in June, can always revise down the road

# Defining a Regular Attendee

**Q: How many hours is considered a Regular Attendee?**

**A: Arizona's Regular Attendee definition is based on DAYS**

- Regular Attendee = 30 days
- Hourly breakdowns for federal reporting





# What Counts as Hours



**Q: Does transportation time count towards hours of attendance?**

**A: Probably not**

- Some programs offer instruction **IN TRANSIT**, most don't (ex: 1 hr commute each way)
- Work with your specialist to discuss what makes sense

# What Counts as Hours

**Q: What about meal/snack times?**

**A: Program hours vs. Instructional hours**

- Program hours should include snack, summer meal times
- Instructional hours are times when students are receiving instruction
  - Could overlap, ex: Books with Breakfast



# Breakdown by Instruction Type

**Q: Will we report attendance by instructional category? Aka literacy vs STEM vs Rec, etc.**

**A: Attendance via AzEDS doesn't ask for this**

- **Activities section of APR DOES ask for how many hours for each category**
  - Just not included in AzEDS upload





# GPRA # 4- In-School Suspension

**Q: For the In -School Suspension data, does that include other types of suspension or discipline?**

**A: No, the GPRA specifically names In - School Suspension as the discipline data point**

# Teacher Survey

**Q: Why is the Teacher Survey only given to grades 1 -5 and not upper grades?**

**A: New GPRAs determined based on research and stakeholder workgroups, including grade levels asked.**

- **Determined grades 1 -5 to be the most meaningful**



# Summary of Classes

**Q: Will the change to two terms for federal reporting change how we report on the Summary of Classes?**

**A: No, the Summary of Classes is a state report**

- Will continue to collect this 2x per year, with Summer, Fall, and Spring reported separately in the template per guidance

# ADE Data Collection

**Q: How will ADE collect all this information?**

**A: Developing systems now.**

- Summer 2021 - updated pdf form for process data
- Spring 2022 process and outcomes - EMAC
