Updates from ED





Dosage- Clarification of Bands for APR

Hours	Rational
Less than 15 hours	Will help capture short, intensive programs like credit recovery
15-44 hours	Captures students who under previous GPRA were "not regular students"
45-89 hours	Captures range of regular students towards research-based dosage band
90-179 hours	Captures range of students at and above research-based dosage band
180-269 hours	Captures students who attend beyond research-based dosage band
270 or more hours	Captures students who attend majority of year









Filtering Attendance in AzEDS Portal

Q: How can I filter my attendance in the AzEDS Portal Reports?





Hours Rounding



Q: How will 21 st CCLC calculate hour bands?

A: Will calculate by adding all minutes together from provided begin/end times for attendance and then rounding as follows:

- 0-29 minutes will round down
- 30-59 minutes will round up



Hours Rounding Cont.



Q: How will 21 st CCLC calculate hour bands?

A: 0-29 mins \$\frac{1}{2}\$, 30-59 mins \$\frac{1}{2}\$

Ex: Henry attends 1 class (2:55 - 3:30) 2 days per week x 22 weeks= 1,540 mins

1,540 mins= 25hrs 40mins

Rounded to 26 hours



Review- Breakdown by Categories

Q: For Summer, will ADE need to know if we offered reading and art during our morning session attendance?

A: Attendance via AzEDS doesn't ask for this

 Activities section of APR DOES ask for how many hours for each category

- Just not included in AzEDS upload





Program Hours vs. Instructional Hours

Q: Is it ok if our program hours are more than our instructional hours?

A: Yes, that may happen depending on how your program handles snack/meals

- Program hours should include snack, summer meal times
- Instructional hours are times when students are receiving instruction
 - Could overlap, ex: Books with Breakfast





ADE Data Collection

Q: Why is ADE collecting so much raw data?

Federal Requirement	Site task	ADE task
APR Partnership Data	Enter partnership and calculate value	Enter data into federal portal which opens 6-8 months post-term
APR Activities and Staffing	Enter into EMAC for summer and academic year terms	Send to ED via API, confirm in federal portal
APR Participation	Enter stu att into SIS for all programming, confirm upload and accuracy in AzEDS Portal	Calculate hours by term, align SSID and send aggregated demographic data ED via API, confirm in federal portal, use to determine Outcomes band per student, add student to EMAC
APR Outcomes	Sites report at student level: GPA (calculating using crosswalk), ISS, Teacher Survey	Determine Outcomes bands, align SSIDs to State Assessment & School Day Att, aggregate all outcomes data based on required bands, send via API, confirm in federal portal

GPRA 1- State Assessment	Grades 4-8
GPRA 2- GPA	Grades 7-8 and 10-12
GPRA 3- School Day Attendance	Grades 1-12
GPRA 4- In-School Suspension	Grades 1-12
GPRA 5- Teacher Survey	Grades 1-5






