Specifically, only 1/2 cup of fruit was served on two days during the review period and this did not meet the minimum daily requirement of 1 cup. This was determined to not be a repeat finding from cycle two and did not contribute toward fiscal action calculation.

Discussed how current system allowed for this to happen and potential changes that could be made to ensure it doesn't continue, such as adjusting the tostada recipe to include 1/2 cup refried beans.
