- Government Performance and Results Act
- Required outcomes reported to Congress once a year, reported in Annual Performance Report (APR)
- Helps us tell the story of 21st CCLC



including Year 5/Year 5Cs who are closing out, if offer programming in June

5 new GPRA Outcome Measures



Two Terms Defined

JunJulAugSeptOctNovDecJanFebMarAprMaySummerAcademic Year

Dosage-Bands for APR

Hours	Rational
Less than 15 hours	Will help capture short, intensive programs like credit recovery
15-44 hours	Captures students who under previous GPRA were "not regular students"
45-89 hours	Captures range of regular students towards research-based dosage band
90-179 hours	Captures range of students at and above research-based dosage band
180-269 hours	Captures students who attend beyond research-based dosage band
270 or more hours	Captures students who attend majority of year



What are the GPRAs?

GPRA 1	Percentage of students in grades 4–8 participating in 21st CCLC programming during the school year and summer who demonstrate growth in reading/language arts on state assessments.
	Percentage of students in grades 4–8 participating in 21st CCLC programming during the school year and summer who demonstrate growth in mathematics on state assessments.
GPRA 2	Percentage of students in grades 7-8 and 10-12 attending 21st CCLC programming during the school year and summer with a prior-year unweighted GPA of less than 3.0 who demonstrated an improved GPA.
GPRA 3	Percentage of students in grades 1-12 participating in 21st CCLC during the school year who had a school day attendance rate at or below 90% in the prior school year and demonstrated an improved attendance rate in the current school year.
GPRA 4	Percentage of students in grades 1-12 attending 21st CCLC programming during the school year and summer who experienced a decrease in in-school suspensions compared to the previous school year.
GPRA 5	Percentage of students in grades 1-5 participating in 21st CCLC programming in the school year and summer who demonstrated an improvement in teacher reported engagement in learning.



Who Reports Outcomes

All students reported for Outcomes

Before, Outcomes only regular attendees

Now, Outcomes for all students who participate 1 or more hours

Outcomes questions narrowed to scope of GPRA grades asked

 If GPRA measure only asks about grades 1-5, will only report this GPRA for grades 1-5

GPRA	Grades Reporting
GPRA 1- State Assessment	Grades 4-8
GPRA 2- GPA	Grades 7-8 and 10-12
GPRA 3- School Day Attendance	Grades 1-12
GPRA 4- In-School Suspension	Grades 1-12
GPRA 5- Teacher Survey	Grades 1-5



What is Staying the Same?



Same vs. Changing

	Previous Practice	Starting in Summer 2021
Student Attendance	Report to AzEDS, any att on a day = 1 day of att	Report to AzEDS, include begin/end time, hours matter
APR Activities and Staffing	Sites report for 16 Activity and 9 Staffing categories	Sites report for 16 Activity and 9 Staffing categories
APR Participation	ADE reporting based on AzEDS attendance, dosage = days of attendance	ADE reporting based on AzEDS attendance, dosage = <i>hours</i> of attendance
APR Outcomes	Sites report aggregate: Grades, Teacher Survey	Sites report, student level: GPA, ISS, Teacher Survey ADE reports: State Assessment, Attendance rate



Funding Formula

Funding formula still using days as the dosage measure Hours now collected to determine dosage for federal reporting



Reporting Systems



Student Attendance in AzEDS

Student attendance reported to AzEDS via SIS

- Student attendance still reported in Student Information System (SIS) and uploaded to ADE viz AzEDS
- Attendance now includes additional data elements- begin/end times for each attendance event- see attendance guidance
- ADE to use those begin/end times to calculate hours of attendance after adding all time together for program year and then rounding-
- > 0-29 mins , 30-59 mins 1





Educational Monitoring, Assistance & Compliance

- Application in ADEConnect
- 21st CCLC will start to transition to EMAC in 2021-2022 program year, including APR data collection
- Sites will be able to enter required reporting and data collection directly into the system, including process and outcomes data
- All communication will be housed directly in the monitoring system

In-School Suspension Definition

Office of Civil Rights Definition

In-School Suspension is an instance in which a child is temporarily removed from his or her regular classroom(s) for at least half a day for disciplinary purposes, but remains under the direct supervision of school personnel. Direct supervision means school personnel are physically in the same location as students under their supervision





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

Government Performance Results Act - GPRA. Changes to GPRA and federal reporting on the Annual Performance Report, begining with the Summer 2021 term.
