RE: A.R.S. 15-901.06 Annual Report- Drop Out Recovery Programs

Per statue, the Arizona Department of Education shall submit an annual report that details the outcomes of dropout recovery programs in Arizona, including the number of pupils who participate in the programs and the number of pupils who participate in the programs and graduate from high school.

To protect the student's anonymity within this report please note that when a group in this report has 10 or fewer students, showing the achievement information may risk an individual student's anonymity. In these cases, we do not report any achievement results for that group, and you will see the \* symbol instead. Likewise, when all students in a group score at the same performance level, reporting "100%" or "0%" would violate each student's anonymity. To protect students' anonymity, we report the percent passing as ">98%" if either 99% or 100% of students in a group pass and we do not report the percent possing as ">98%" if either 99% or 100% of students in a group pass and we do not report the percent passing as ">98%" if either 100%" if either 100% of students in a group pass and we do not report the percent passing as ">0% of students in a group pass, and we do not report the percent passing as "<2%" if either 1% or 0% of students in a group pass, and we do not report the breakdown for each performance level.

In addition, rounding the percentages allows us to offer additional anonymity while still providing the most accurate data. Because of this, percentages of the performance levels may not total to 100% or precisely equal the percentage passing.

The following table provided data for July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021. This includes the approved districts and charters facilitating dropout recovery programs with their total student count (Headcount), the total number of students enrolled in dropout recovery programs drawing Average Daily Membership (ADM), and the total number of students in the dropout recover programs that successfully graduate from high school.
