GPRA 4: In-School Suspension Definition

GPRA 4	Percentage of students in grades 1-12 attending 21st CCLC programming during the school year and summer who experienced a decrease in in-school suspensions compared to the previous school year.
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Office of Civil Rights Definition

In-School Suspension is an instance in which a child is temporarily removed from his or her regular classroom(s) for at least half a day for disciplinary purposes, but remains under the direct supervision of school personnel. Direct supervision means school personnel are physically in the same location as students under their supervision

GPA Grading Scale Crosswalk

GPRA 2	Percentage of students in grades 7-8 and 10-12 attending 21st CCLC programming during the school year and summer with a prior-year unweighted GPA of less than 3.0 who demonstrated an improved GPA.
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Letter Grade	Sample Word Grade (1)	Sample Word Grade (2)	Percent age Grade	STC in AzEDS	GPA
A	Exceeding Expectations	Advanced	90-100%	Above Average	4.0
B	Above Expectations	Proficient	80-89%	Above Average	3.0
C	At Expectations	Approaching	70-79%	Average	2.0
D/F	Below Expectations	Beginning	Below 70%	Below Average	Below 2.0

What about students who may have come from a different school?

Ex: 7th graders who were at a K-6?
9th graders?

FAQ- Instructional Hours

Q: Which hours do I add into my SIS attendance? Instructional hours or program hours?

A: Instructional.

- ✓ Instructional hours = attendance hours.
- ✓ Program hours = hours the center is operating
 - might align exactly or program hours might be slightly larger

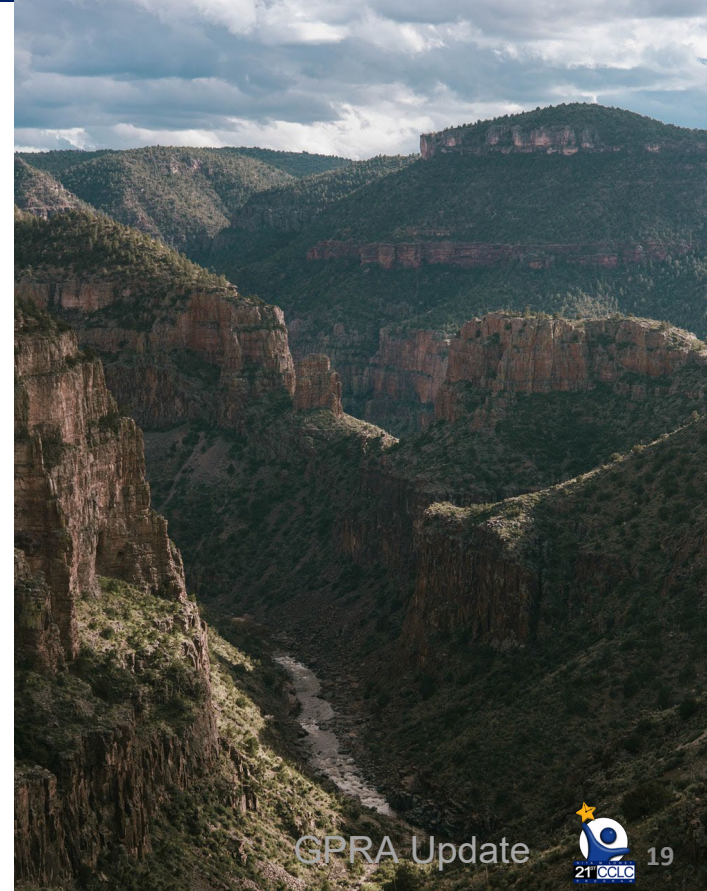
