



Co-Operating CNPs Through June 30, 2022

This chart is specific to operators of Child Nutrition Programs (CNPs), federally assisted meal programs administered by ADE from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA).

School Food Authorities (SFAs)

SFAs have the option to operate the following CNPs:

- SSO
- SBP/NSLP
- ASCSP
- At-Risk

COMBINATION #1

SSO

SSO:	At-Risk:
2 meals/snacks (cannot claim a SSO Lunch and SSO Supper on the same day)	1 meal 1 snack

1 SBP meal
1 NSLP meal
1 At-Risk meal
1 At-Risk snack

COMBINATION #3

SBP/NSLP



ASCSP

Maximums per day

1 SBP meal
1 NSLP meal
1 ASCSP snack

COMBINATION #4

SSO



ASCSP

Maximums per day

1 ASCSP snack

SSO:
2 meals/snacks
(cannot claim a SSO Lunch and SSO Supper on the same day)



Best Practice Combination

This combination allows SFAs to serve 3 meals and 1 snack (all free of charge for students) each day with the largest reimbursement:

SSO Breakfast
SSO Lunch
At-Risk Snack
At-Risk Supper

Meals Served on Non-School Days

(e.g., weekends and breaks)

At-Risk ONLY

Maximums per day

1 At-Risk meal
1 At-Risk snack

(At-Risk is the only CNP that SFAs may operate on non-school days)
