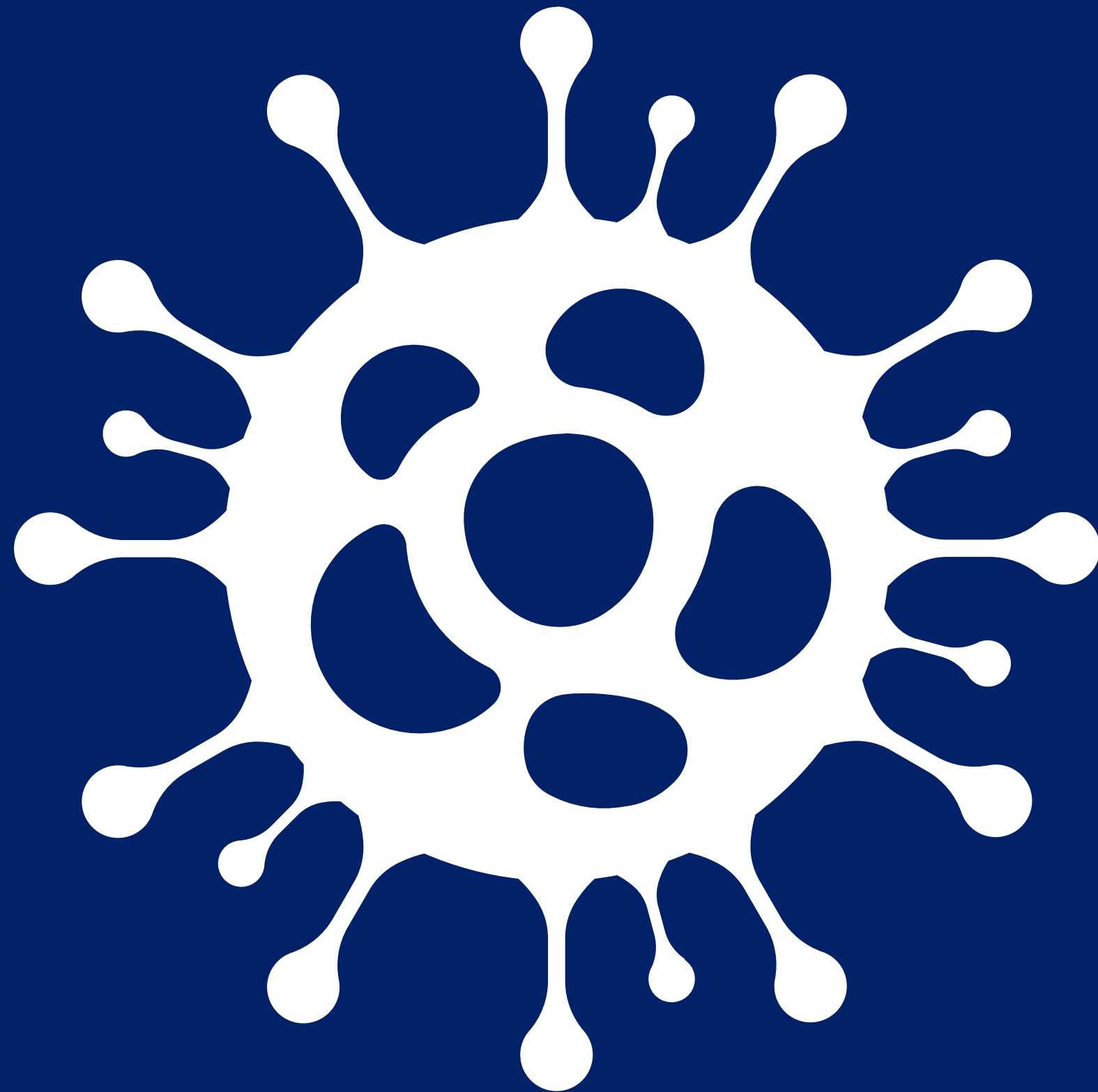

FOOD SUPPLY DISRUPTIONS

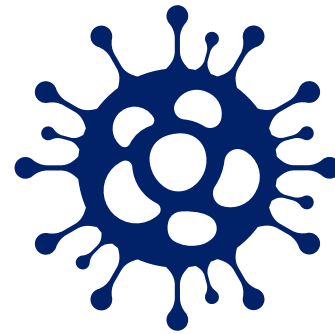
A food supply disruption is...

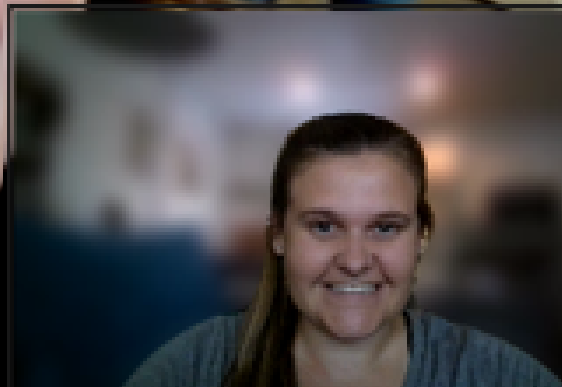
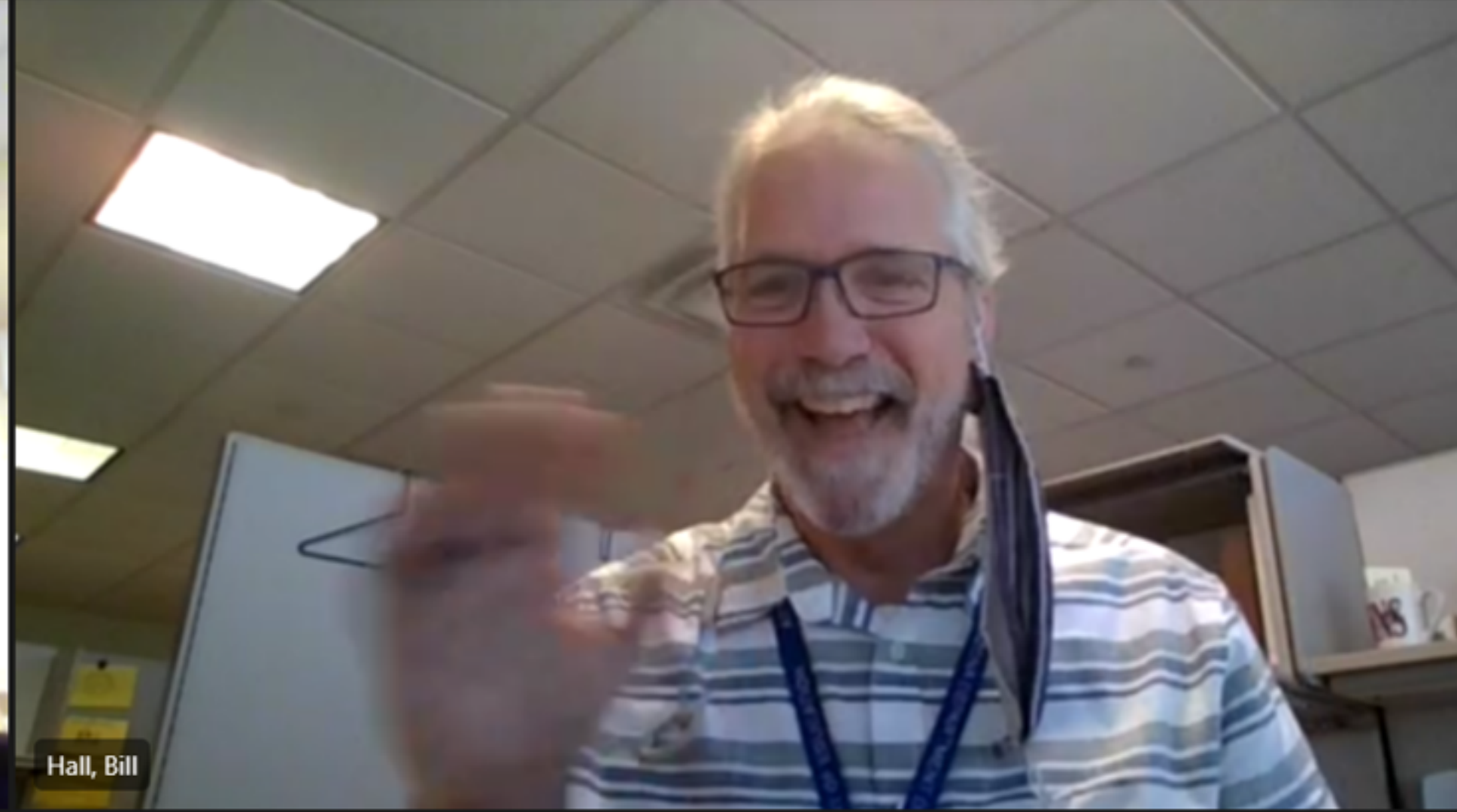

- This team will support all CNP operators in their efforts to serve menus that meet the desired nutrition standards of the individual local-level program.

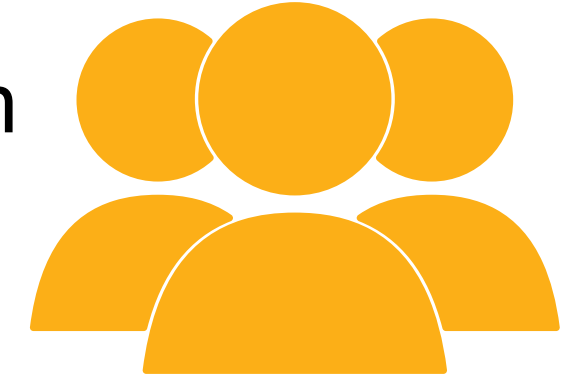

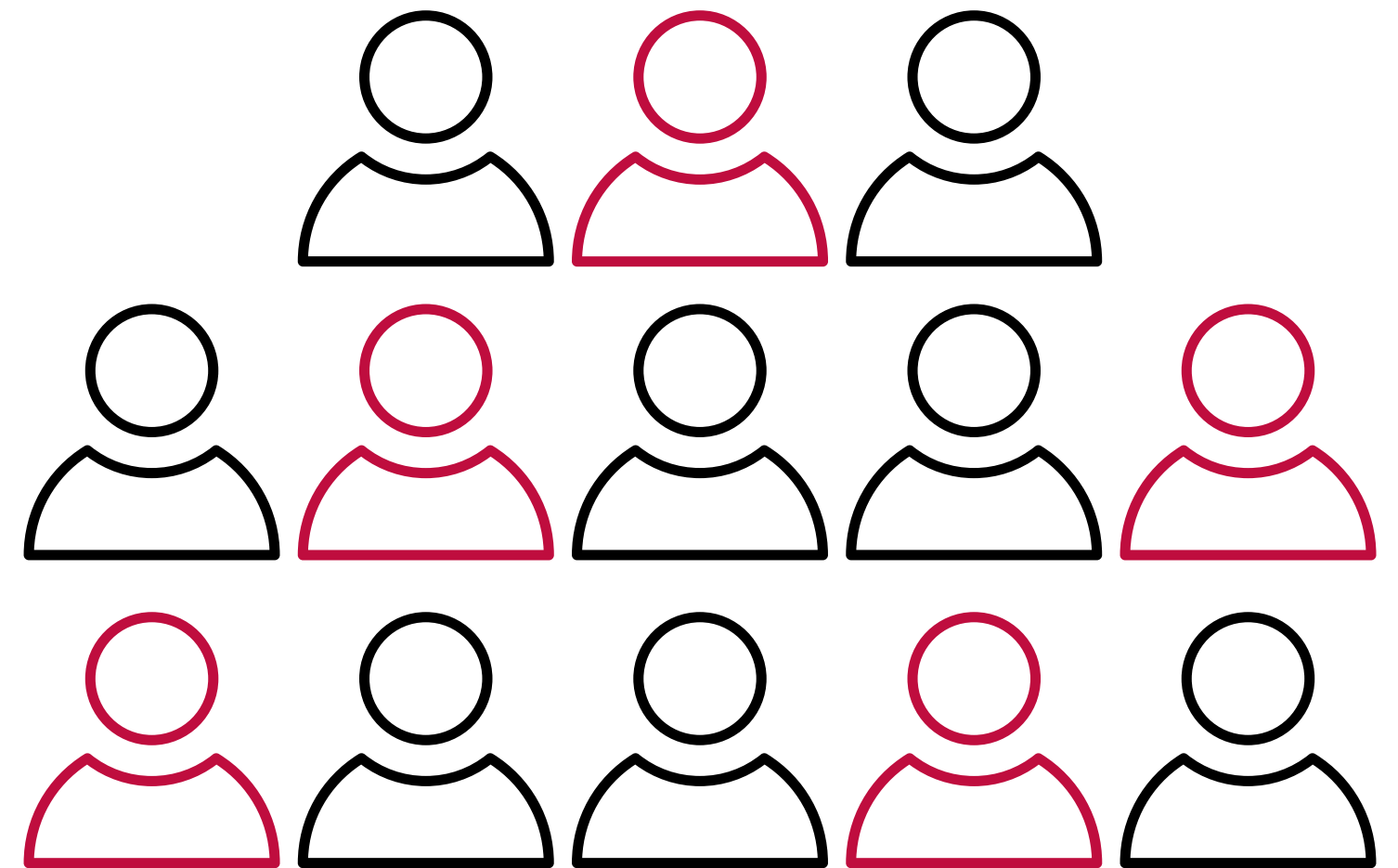

It took me nearly all day to finalize weekly food orders for 5 breakfast and lunch schools and 2 breakfast schools (lunch meals are vended). Had to find subs for many entrees and breakfast components. I ended up paying \$1.04 each for 600 burger buns. Between labor shortages, new staff and food shortages this SY is far worse than last SY when we needed to figure out how to safely serve meals to in person students during a pandemic.

Tomorrow's goal is to find a reliable bread vendor and figure out what we will use for disposable trays in schools that cannot use permanent trays.

Frustrated, stressed and defeated just touches the surface of how I feel every day.

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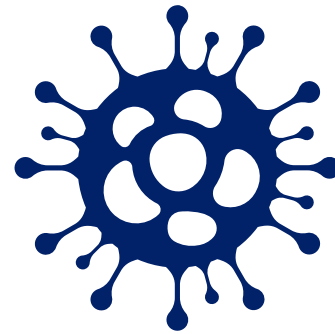
