The Maricopa Community College Dual Enrollment Teachers Scholarship website launches!

As you may be aware, Dual Enrollment instructors teaching in academic disciplines at a Maricopa Community College must have a master's degree in the content area or a master's degree in any area with 18 credit hours of graduate-level courses in the area they plan to teach. ASU and NAU have developed graduate-level opportunities for our Dual Enrollment instructors! Additionally, funding opportunities are available for high school instructors who are currently teaching dual enrollment and for those new to the program.

The NEW Arizona Teachers Academy tuition scholarship is a great way for teachers to pay for those credits while pursuing their DE instructor qualifications. The scholarship funds are available for high school instructors who want to teach dual enrollment and to those who are already dual enrollment instructors.
