October 1 Data Collection (ODC)



October 1 Data Collection (ODC)

- Federal requirement under Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) Section 618
- Data is reported to the Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP)
- Includes:
 - Personnel
 - Census
- Electronic signature required



October 1 SPED Census

 Used to verify the unduplicated count of students receiving special education and related services on October 1 ages 3-21

 Used to determine base funding for all PEAs in Federal Part B allocations



October 1 Data Collection

Phase I

- October 1: Count your SPED students
- Student verification and personnel counts due in ESS October 1 Data Collection application with electronic signature

Phase II

- Reconciliation begins
- SPED07 report available
- SPED data due in AzEDS
- Reconciliation due
- ADE submits data to OSEP

Phase III

- Non–Reconciliation begins
- Submission due in ESSOctober 1 DataCollection application



October 1 Data Collection - Personnel

- Fully certified or not
- Providing SPED/related services
- Full-Time Equivalency (FTE)
- Three Sections:
 - ✓ Teachers
 - ✓ Paraprofessionals
 - ✓ Related service providers





October 1 Data Collection - Strategies

Child Count

- Start early and get your team involved
- Save all documentation
- Develop a plan to avoid non-reconciliation
- Check reports regularly

Personnel

- Work with Human Resources
- Double-check FTE calculations

ASDB Reporting

Initial Enrollment	IEP Determination	Voucher Status	Who Reports
Public District or Charter	Transfer to ASDB Campus	District or Charter approves ASDB voucher	ASDB reports student
Public District or Charter	Receives services from ASDB through fee-for- service, students remains on District or Charter campus	N/A	District or Charter reports student
Public District or Charter	Receives services from ASDB through Regional Co-Op, students remains on District or Charter campus	District or Charter approves ASDB voucher	District or Charter reports student

Preschool LRE Codes

- The Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) A.R.S. § 15-101(12) provides a definition of elementary grades which indicates "Elementary grades means kindergarten programs and grades one through eight."
 - Parentally Placed Preschool Students are excluded because they do not meet the requirement of attending an elementary school (Proportionate Share Code Removal, memo)
- Reporting Requirements in AzEDS
 - Preschool students on an individualized education program (IEP)
 - Public School Districts & Charter Schools who have a preschool program are to report in AzEDS (Tuition Payer Code, <u>memo</u>)
- Reporting Requirements for October 1
 - Verification and Reconciliation
 - Include preschool students on an IEP
 - Parentally Placed Student
 - Public School Districts Only
 - Do not include preschool students in the Parentally Placed Student count

Per your Request

- Ungraded Elementary (UE)
- A.R.S. § 15-901 (A)(1)(b)(i)
 - Ungraded group B children with disabilities who are at least 5, but under 6, years of age by September 1
 - Must be enrolled in an instructional program that meets for a total of at least 712 hours for a 180day school year

Group B Needs

A, EDP, HI, MD, MDSSI, MOID, OI, SID, VI

Integrity errors

- 10023 must be 5 by January 1st
- 10061 must have group B need and be of KG age
- 10067 must have group B need for every day of UE membership
