



APR Data Reporting System

21st CCLC is building a standalone Data Reporting System for APR

Why?

- IT logistics- timelines, database work, prevents interruptions to FMAC
- User experience- very different reporting than EMAC

What does this mean for me?

- All APR data reporting for 21st CCLC will be within this new system, not EMAC
- Accessed through ADEConnect (like other apps- GME, EMAC, EMS)

Timeline for implementation?

- Anticipate starting to train in March/April with data reporting window open late spring/summer


