

Additional Things to Consider for your Position Descriptions:

- We recommend posting the requirements for ADE Certification as your minimum qualifications.
- As a reminder, in addition to meeting the full list of <u>ADE Certification</u> <u>Requirements</u>:
 - A Certified School Counselor must have a graduate degree from a guidance and counseling program, counseling, social work, or psychology program, or a behavioral health license from AZBHE.
 - For School Social Workers, a Master's in Social Work degree is required.
- We **do not require** School Social Workers and School Counselors to have licensure through AZBHE (e.g. LMSW, LPC). This decision will be left up to the district, unless this is one of the applicants qualifications for their ADE School Counseling Certificate.
- You may consider visiting the <u>Arizona Educations Employment Board</u> to view how other schools are writing their position descriptions.

Places to Post your Positions

- Tips to improving access to your school or district website:
 - Ask someone unfamiliar to first locate your website, and then locate the employment listings. Are they easy to find?
 - Consider adding a scrolling banner or button on the home page of your website directing people to employment opportunities
 - Write a blog post / social media post highlighting your new school counselor or school social worker position.
