ECAP requirements as outlined in [Board Rule R7-2-302.05](#)
(Approved February 25, 2008):

- Academic Goals
- Career Goals
- Postsecondary Education Goals
- Extracurricular Goals

ECAP – Four Attributes

An ECAP process portfolio has four attributes which should be documented, reviewed and updated, at minimum, annually:

<u>Academic</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Plan coursework to meet High School requirements• Document postsecondary education goals• Record academic achievements/awards	<u>Career</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Explore career opportunities• Define a career goal aligned to personal interests, skills, and values• Explore needed educational requirements to achieve the career goal
<u>Postsecondary</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Explore admissions requirements• Complete necessary applications• Create a financial assistance plan	<u>Extracurricular</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Clubs, leadership opportunities, CTSO, athletics, community service, work experience, internships, job shadowing• Enhance college applications and resumes• Explore interests and skills

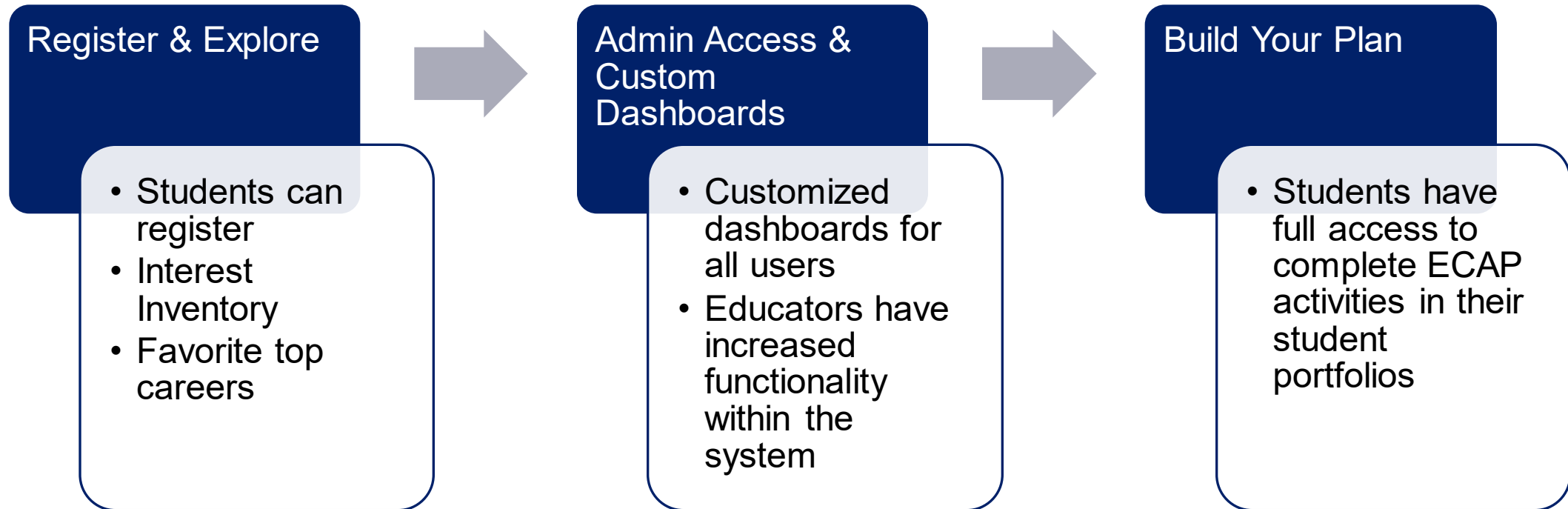


Compliance

Each year ADE requests schools to submit two ECAP documents:

1. A copy of the school-wide implementation action plan or calendar (action plan or calendars should include: **What, Where, When, Who** in order to present a clear picture of you ECAP process for ALL students
2. A copy of a completed ECAP from **one** student from the graduating class **with all identifying student information removed in order to be FERPA complaint**

Highlights



- FREE
- Created for us - not a “canned” platform – constantly updating
- Open to all students – focus on middle/high school
- Open system – registration is not required to explore – registration is required to save information
- Easy to create accounts – easy to reset passwords
- Students never lose access to their account – even if they move schools
- Schools can customize certain aspects of the platform to individualize for their school
- Easy to share with parents




