

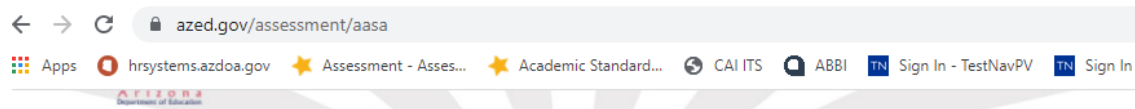

# What you need to know about the Field Test...

- ▶ ORF will be assessed during the regular AASA testing window
  - ▶ Online Schools: April 4 - 29, 2022
  - ▶ Paper Schools: April 4 - 13, 2022 (schools will choose to use either computer or telephone for ORF Section)
- ▶ Students will be recorded reading 3 passages for 1 minute each
- ▶ Score will be Words Correct Per Minute (WCPM)
- ▶ Spring 2022 is the Field Test, so scores will not be reported to schools/parents
  - ▶ Scores will become part of Reading scores and MOWR requirements in 2023

## Arizona's Academic Standards Assessment (AASA)

### Grades 3-8 Testing:

AASA is the statewide achievement test for Arizona students in Grades 3-8. All Arizona public school students in Grades 3 - 8 will take the grade level AASA assessments in English Language Arts and Mathematics.

### High School Testing:

Cohort 2025 (typically grade 9) students will take the ACT Aspire assessment.

Cohort 2023 (typically grade 11) students will take the ACT assessment.

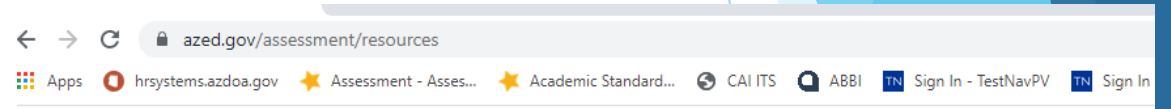

# ORF Passages

- ▶ 3 passages
  - ▶ Bank of passages randomly assigned
- ▶ Variety of Grade 3 lexile levels/ranges
- ▶ Vary between literature, information (no poetry)
- ▶ May have some dialogue


# Standards Team - Information



- ▶ As a reminder the reason for ORF is...
  - ▶ To measure fluency.
    - ▶ Fluency is a measure of speed, accuracy and prosody. All 3 are needed.
    - ▶ Fluency is an indication of efficiency in decoding which leaves more cognitive load for comprehension.
