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# 1 Introduction

In accordance with Article 15 Empowerment Scholarship Accounts Rule 7-2-1503 Department Responsibilities, the Arizona Department of Education and the Empowerment Scholarship Account Program present this quarterly report to the Arizona State Board of Education. This report reflects data and information from quarter 1 of fiscal year 2022 and covers the time from July 1, 2021 to September 30, 2021. As stipulated in Rule 7-2-1503 item 5, this report includes the following:

- a) The number of students in the program disaggregated by eligibility, grade level and the school district or charter school associated with each student;
- b) The annual award amount associated with each student;
- c) The number of ESA applications received, approved, and denied in the preceding quarter, including the justification for the denied applications;

## 2 Students in the Program

This section includes the number of students in the program disaggregated by eligibility, grade level, and the school district or charter school associated with each student.

As of September 30, 2021, there were 10,699 active students in the ESA program. By comparison, there were 9,669 students in the program during quarter 4 and 9,831 in quarter 3.

## 2.3 Students by Associated School District or Charter School

Under most circumstances, a student prior must have previously attended a public school in Arizona for at least 100<sup>1</sup> days of the prior school year to be eligible for an ESA. This section provides information regarding the associated schools active ESA students attended prior to joining to ESA program.

As of September 30, 2021, ESA students previously attended 408 of the 667 total number of school districts and charter districts (referred to as local education agencies or LEAs) in Arizona. The complete list of students by associated LEA can be found in Appendix A. In Quarter 4 FY21, 380 of the 667 ESA students previously attended school districts and charter districts.

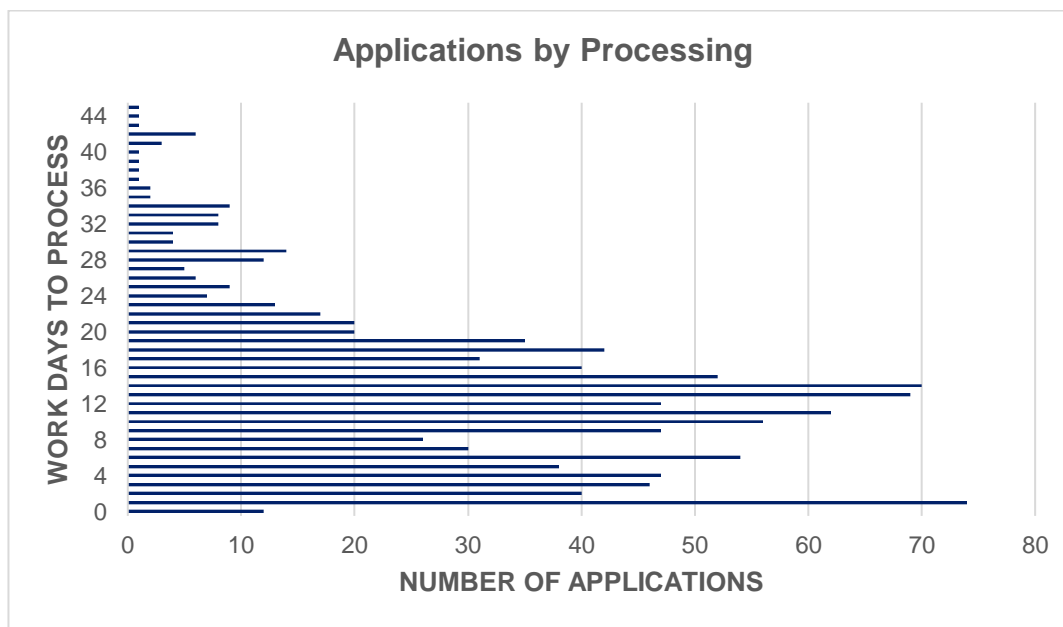

### 6.1 Parent Feedback

The ESA program solicits parent feedback through the following processes:

- ESA Parent Advisory Council
- Written comments
- Electronic surveys
- Town Hall meetings

#### Parent Advisory Council

The Department held one Parent Advisory Council (PAC) meeting during quarter 1, on September 28, 2021. The meeting included agenda items such as the recent ESA statutory changes, a discussion about the opportunities and challenges when moving to a risk-based, audit approach, as well getting initial thoughts and feedback on how we might improve the ESA Parent Handbook to allow for more flexibility for families. The PAC meeting was open to all families. There were 11 PAC members in attendance with 84 parents observing. The PAC meeting notes are included in Appendix B.

#### Electronic Surveys

The Department continues to provide a survey link to all tickets received through the Department's HelpDesk for families to provide feedback on the timeliness, completeness, quality, and helpfulness of the response regarding their request. Families are also given an opportunity on the survey link to provide general feedback. During Quarter 1, the Department received 204 responses to HelpDesk-linked surveys and only 3 Website-linked surveys:

#### Town Hall Meetings

The Department held two town hall meetings during Quarter 1. ESA staff gave a brief presentation on a key program topic and then answered questions that had been submitted by families in advance. Questions were also taken during each town hall.

- Thursday, August 26, 2021, from 7-7:30pm attended by 112 stakeholders
- Wednesday, September 1, 2021, from 7-7:30pm attended by 128 stakeholders

## 6.2 ADE Response to Feedback

### Communications and Training

The Department continues to review and update its communications strategy for sharing information with prospective and existing Account Holders.

In addition to a weekly newsletter, the Department hosts a monthly town hall featuring a presentation and an opportunity for Q and A. The next town hall is scheduled for November 3, 2021 from 7-8pm.

### ESA Weekly Newsletter

All families receive a weekly newsletter, called the ESA Weekly Bulletin, that includes upcoming town hall information and other helpful program tips.

### Expense Approval Process

In response to parent feedback regarding consistency and timeliness of the expense approval process, the ESA program team is undergoing continuous improvement for processes and procedures and is conducting ongoing staff training.

In addition, the Department is evaluating the current functionality of the database and exploring opportunities to improve searchability and integration with the financial management vendor and exploring a risk-based audit process.

### Appeals

In response to parent feedback on the Department's facilitation of the appeals process, the Department is working with its Assistant Attorney General and the State Board of Education to streamline the appeals process and conform to recently adopted legislative changes.

### 7.2 Providers and Vendors

As of September 30, 2021, there were 2,033 vendors/providers in the ClassWallet application, and an additional 345 private schools registered for Direct Pay.

### 7.3 Communications & Trainings

### 7.4 Parent Concerns and Responses

The Department was notified on September 27, 2021 that some ESA parents were able to view other ESA parent names and email addresses in a certain user search feature inside the ClassWallet portal. The Department notified all account holders of the situation on September 27, 2021. ClassWallet removed the search feature on September 28, 2021 and they are currently working with multiple quality assurance teams and an outside consultant to ensure that privacy controls are strengthened.

### 7.5 Other Requests

There were no additional requests identified by the Board for this report.

## 8 Performance Metrics

This section includes information on the performance metrics on the critical functions of the ESA program from July 1, 2021 through September 30, 2021.

### 8.1 Call Center Data

- Total number of calls (in/outbound) 8,960
- Average call wait time 3:59 minutes
- 27% of calls answered within 8 seconds, 43% of calls answered withing 30 seconds, 47% of calls answered withing 60 seconds
- Average handling time for inbound calls 5:23 minutes
- Average handling time for outbound calls 2:03 minutes
- 12% of calls abandoned (Note: Industry average is 20%)

### 8.2 Help Desk Service Tickets

- Total number of tickets that required response 2,697 (July 985, August 1,085, September 627)
- Program/Support Related Tickets: average 5 workdays to complete
- Compliance/Expense Related Tickets: averaged 13 workdays to complete

ESA staff reviewed **33,965** ClassWallet orders for reimbursement (receipts with credentials), Marketplace (purchases with over 2,033 vendors/providers), and Direct Pay (private schools and approved vendors).

## Appendix B: PAC Meeting Notes

### PAC Meeting Highlights

September 28, 2021

#### ESA Program Updates

1. Discussion on ESA program changes coming on September 29, 2021
  - a. 45 days to process an application and send parent contract is now 30 days
  - b. The FIRST 100 days public school attendance requirement changes to ANY 45 days (can be current or prior school year, or a combination of both years)
  - c. Kindergarten online instruction requirement changes to 200 hours
  - d. No change in hourly requirement for 1<sup>st</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades
  - e. ESA funds can be used in combination with private health insurance to pay for educational therapies (only for applicants qualifying as a student with a disability)
  - f. Students who qualify for the Free and/or Reduced Lunch Program AND who are attending a school or district assigned a letter grade of D or F or who is eligible to attend Kindergarten and who resides within the attendance boundary of a school or district assigned a letter grade of D or F, do not need to meet the 45 days public attendance requirement.

#### **NOTE:**

*ADE will be hosting a Town Hall on these program changes on October 7<sup>th</sup>. Registration information is available on our website and has been emailed to all families.*

*Implementation was required by state law to begin on September 29<sup>th</sup>. Depending on Arizona State Board of Education rule-making and the Board's vote in January 2022, there could possibly be adjustments to the way these program updates are implemented.*

#### Risk-Based Account Auditing

1. Discussion about moving from approving every item to a risk-based system
  - a. ADE staff receives thousands of requests for preapproval/approval of individual items
  - b. Current staffing limitations mean that a parent can be left waiting weeks for a response
  - c. Moving to a risk-based approach has been a continued recommendation by the Auditor General
  - d. Would involve reviewing a percentage of account transactions based on risk
  - e. The risk level of an account would increase based on transaction history.



**Example:** Account with history of attempted cash withdrawals could be given a higher risk rating and could possibly have transactions viewed more frequently.

- f. This new process would be phased-in, possibly looking at a January 2022 start date
- g. Parents could still request a preapproval, if desired

**Opportunities:**

Smother process

Can be easier with well-defined process

Less frustration because wait time is reduced

**Challenges:**

Concern when purchasing items without approval in advance

Need a well-defined audit process

**ESA Parent Handbook – Page 19**

- 1. Discussion on how we can better align handbook with statute and rule, as well as provide parents with flexibility and clarity when making purchases
  - a. Growing the list of “approved educational materials” found on page 19
  - b. Items listed under the “approved educational materials” section DO not require curriculum
  - c. Some of the non-approved materials on page 19 can be educational and could potentially be moved to the “approved educational materials” section.
  - d. Consider rewording of “non-approved materials” to provide more clarity  
**Example:** Some items listed as “non-approved”, “might” be approved with curriculum

**Suggestions:**

“Toys” to “Educational Toys” (*Legos, board games, puzzles, etc.*)

“Workshops” to “Educational Workshops” (*science workshops, art workshops, etc.*)

“Kits, Boxes and Sticker Books” to “*Educational Kits, Boxes or Sticker Books*”

Art supplies or consumable materials as part of a curriculum

Educational rugs (ABCs, colors, etc.) as part of a curriculum

Expand manipulatives (*letters, science, social studies, history, reading, social skills*)

**NOTE:**

*Any handbook suggestions will be compiled and shared with the ADE policy team, the Attorney General's office and finally given to the Arizona State Board of Education for approval.*

***Other questions and topics of discussion:***

- Can ESA clearly explain who qualifies for associated goods/assistive technology and what documentation needs to be provided? *Will be a future topic for town hall and/or weekly bulletin*
- Can PAC members observe a Compliance meeting? *Will need to be virtual and will work on scheduling.*
- Can we have a mentorship program for new parents (emotional support and resources)? *We are starting ESA 101 town halls, the first one will be on 11-3-21.*
- Can we have videos of real families utilizing the program on the website? *We are working on adding additional content to website, will discuss video possibilities with leadership.*
- ADE is working with the State Board of Education and will continue to collaborate as the rule making process continues. *Look for communication from SBE on public comment period.*
- Can we expand the resources available for Spanish language speakers? *Many current staffers are bilingual, will continue this conversation.*
