



# FY2022 SCHOOL SAFETY PROGRAM TRAINING SCHEDULE

## *How to Register*

Step 1: Visit the Law for Kids [website](https://lawforkids.org/ssp-training): <https://lawforkids.org/ssp-training>

Step 2: Click on the Training tab on the left-hand panel and select your required training

Step 3: Create an account or login to proceed.

NOTE: Training attendance is directly linked to the name of the person who registered for the training. Thus, **each person must register separately to ensure they receive their own training link**. To receive full credit for attending the training, you must login using your own training link and your own device. **Failure to meet your annual training requirement can result in your school district/charter being placed on programmatic hold next year.**

## *Before the Training*

Pre-work is required for all trainings, and it must be completed prior to attending the training. Pre-work for each training is as follows:

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## *Leadership 100: The Basics*

This half-day virtual training covers the program’s philosophy, requirements, individual stakeholder roles, cultural responsiveness, and school safety related topics. This is a live, interactive training, so please register for the time slot when you can be fully present. As pre-work, you are required to complete six self-paced video trainings prior to attending the training. The videos will be available on the School Safety Program website <https://www.azed.gov/wellness/ssp>. Completing the pre-work allows us to spend more time in the live training on group activities, addressing questions, and interacting with one another.

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and allow time to share resources and build collaborative connections with other CSWs in the School Safety Program. Arrive prepared with your pre-work complete. Pre-work information is provided in your registration confirmation email.

## *New Officer Training*

This four-day virtual training covers community-oriented policing, cultural responsiveness, the role of school-based officers, and an introduction to Law Related Education (LRE) as an essential prevention tool. **Day 1** begins with Leadership 100, where SROs and JPOs will attend training with their administrator(s). Attending this training together encourages program cohesion and effective program implementation. **Days 2** covers child development, trauma-informed practices, working with students in special education, and cultural responsiveness. **Days 3 and 4** do a deep dive into LRE, providing officers with classroom management techniques, space to share ideas and lesson plan, and knowledge of learning styles. Officers leave with resources and tools ready to teach in the classroom. Arrive prepared with your pre-work complete. Pre-work information is provided in your registration confirmation email.

**Who Attends?** Officers **NEW** to the program in FY 2022 **OR** who joined the program in FY 2021 but did not attend the *New Officer Training* in FY 2021 **OR** who were not on the last grant cycle (FY18-FY20).

**NOTE:** Day 1 of *New Officer Training* is combined with *Leadership 100: The Basics*. It is recommended that a new officer's District and/or Site Administrator register for L100, so they attend Day 1 together to ensure they are in accordance with the program philosophy and requirements.
