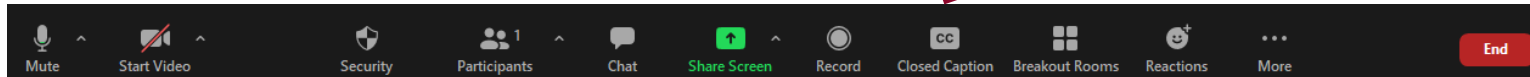

Reminders

October 1 Data Collection – Phase III: Non-Reconciliation

Only applicable to PEAs who **DO NOT** reconcile their Phase I October 1 Verification Count

- Phase III Open Date: *April 13, 2022*
- Phase III Close Date: *May 25, 2022*
- * *If applicable, keep record of why your verification count didn't reconcile (i.e., miss counted student(s), unresolved integrity error, etc.).*

IDEA Statement of Assurances (SOA)

All PEAs must submit a SOA before submitting data to any of the ESS Data Collection & Reporting Applications or approval of IDEA Grant applications in FY23.

- Open Date: *February 2, 2022*
- Close Date: *June 30, 2022*

Emailing Data Management: SSID

Please do not send student names in your inquiries to protect student privacy. Providing only the SSID will suffice.

Integrity Errors -40040 and -40057 - Concurrencies

- **Check the SPED50 Report available in AzEDS Portal**
 - Check SPED99 if the student with concurrency issue is not on the SPED50 report.
 - INTEG15 will also name the concurrent PEA in the error message.
 - If your PEA name is in the INTEG15 error message, your PEA is concurrent with itself, or the other PEA has orphan data.
- **Contact the concurrent PEA and document all efforts to clear up the concurrency.**
 - E-mail
 - Phone Call
- **October Data Collection**
 - If concurrency integrity errors are not fixed, both PEAs will be required to complete Phase III
 - The PEA will provide documentation that efforts were made to clear up the error. If the error is due to the other PEA's inability to resolve and this is the only reason for non-reconciliation, then PEA Determination will not be affected.

Top 3 Integrity Errors

-40069, -40055 & -40044

Top 3 Integrity Errors

1. [Integrity Error -40069](#)

Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) must be within a valid enrollment at a school. The error may be caused by a student not having valid enrollment due to missing DOR, grade or calendar.

2. [Integrity Error -40055](#)

Invalid exit code combination; refer to the [SPED Exit Validation matrix](#).

3. [Integrity Error -40044](#)

There is more than one LRE code specified at a single point in time for this need.
