- ✓ AZ-specific items will be used on AzSCI - Will have multiple stimuli to go with a set of items.
- ✓ Will have various item types: Multiple choice/multi-select and Technology enhanced: inline, glider, fill in the blank, two-part questions, and more
- ✓ Calculator: Desmos
- ✓ Based on grade bands: Students in Grade 5 will be tested on standards from Grades 3-5 and students in Grade 8 will be tested on standards from Grades 6-8.
- ✓ Assessing Essential Standards in physical science, earth and space science, and life science in high school
