Grant Purpose



The purpose of this grant is to provide additional funding to sustain and/or expand successful strategies and action steps implemented during the prior year using school improvement funding.



To be eligible for the FY23 School Improvement Sustainability Grant, LEA/school must meet **ALL** the following requirements:

- Been identified for CSI low achievement, TSI or participated in ELEVATE Cohorts 3-5, MTSS Cohort 1-2, or SIG Cohort 5 schools
- Received an FY22 Grant from School Support and Improvement
- Submitted FY22 Grant Evaluation Tool reflection to program specialist
- Completed **new** 2022-23 CNA in GME
- Conducted thorough root cause analyses (fishbone diagrams) in GME
- Completed 2022-23 LEA and School IAP in GME, including SSI required goals

Additional Notes...

- §This is a *competitive grant*
- §Complete a detailed application
- §Include all required elements and documentation
- §Application is scored using a scoring rubric
- §70% of points are required for funding

No LEA out of fiscal and/or programmatic compliance will be considered eligible

For-profit charters are not eligible to apply

Allowable Expenditures

All Sustainability grant activities funded with Title I 1003(a) School Improvement funds must be reasonable and necessary and directly related to the implementation of the LEA and School Integrated Action Plans (IAPs).

All activities must address the Needs and Root Causes identified in the schools' Comprehensive Needs Assessments (CNA) and advance the overall goal to increase academic achievement.

Allowable Expenditures

- Strategies and action steps based on CNA data analysis specific to student achievement
- Data driven decision-making process
- Leadership development
- Professional learning activities specific to school reform, subgroup achievement, MTSS, SEL, (including conferences and related travel)
- Instructional infrastructure
- Specialized supplies directly related to action steps specific to subgroup achievement
- Pay for off contract work (above and beyond duties necessary to job function); committees, professional learning activities, research specific to student achievement
 - Board approved hourly rate paid, must be reasonable
 - Requires time and effort logs
- FY22 funded positions, if still needed, so long as this additional year will lead to sustainability. Ensure there is a plan to fund in the future after this grant ends.



Carnegie Learning High School Math Solution curriculum combines traditional textbook and workbook materials with self-paced individualized instruction via automated tutoring software.

Three studies, all involving high school students, were evaluated. Results for the second cohort were significantly positive which qualified this blended curriculum for the ESSA "strong" category.

White papers, theories of action, reviews of literature, and pre/post test data are not sufficient and do not meet ESSA's requirements
