 - Process Data- Partnerships, Activities, Staffing, Family Engagement, Overview of the Grantee (Contact info and COVID narrative)
 - Outcome Data- Student Level Data
 - Submitted in System
- Due Dates
 - Process Data- Due by June 17, 2022
 - Outcome Data- Due by September 16, 2022

Spotlight on: Data Collection

OPTIONAL APR Data Collection Templates

- To help collect data prior to entering in system
 - Useful if collecting from multiple sources or if district will be doing data entry
- Can be edited/adapted as necessary
 - NOT where data is submitted (that's the 21st CCLC APR Data Reporting System, coming April 2022)

Updated GPA Crosswalk

Letter Grade	Sample Word Grade (1)	Sample Word Grade (2)	Percentage Grade	STC in AzEDS	Sample Standards based- pts	GPA
A	Exceeding Expectations	Advanced	90-100%	Above Average	4- Advanced	4.0
B	Above Expectations	Proficient	80-89%	Above Average	3- Meets Expectations for Target	3.0
C	At Expectations	Approaching	70-79%	Average	2- Partial Mastery	2.0
D/F	Below Expectations	Beginning	Below 70%	Below Average	1- Little or no Mastery	Below 2.0

GPA Calculations

Unweighted GPA is reported for all students in grades 7-8 and 10-12.

- Many schools with these grades already calculate GPA
- Where they don't, GPA will need to be calculated
- Reported at the student level, prior year (FY21) and current year (FY22)
- Can use crosswalk as a tool to help with this

GPA- Calculating GPA

Examples of how to use crosswalk to calculate unweighted GPA, *if necessary*

21st CCLC APR Data Reporting System- ADEConnect Access

- 21st CCLC APR Data Reporting System will be accessible in ADEConnect, Entity Admin to assign, like all ADEConnect apps
- ☐ Districts, decide who will do data entry (district or school)

Data Collection

- ☐ If you need to collect from multiple people sources, start getting that ready
 - Teacher Surveys (grades 1-5), can use templates for process data to help organize data

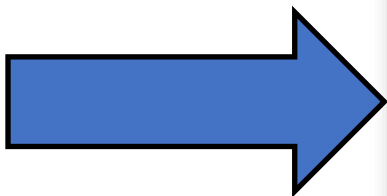
