Performance Standard 2: Meal Components & Quantities - Critical Area							

Quantities observed during the review period did not meet minimum amounts required by the meal pattern. One of the breakfast choices for the K-12 age group was Kix, which was served with crackers for a total of 1.5 whole grain rich oz. per day. The weekly 9 oz. requirement was not met. This was not a repeat finding from previous cycle and did not contribute toward fiscal action calculations.

Discussed how current system allowed for this to happen and potential changes that could be made to ensure it doesn't continue (e.g., changes in serving utensils, recipes, etc.). Discussed with cafeteria staff how to properly identify and count reimbursable meals, as well as procedures if a student does not select a reimbursable meal. 3 Quantities observed during the review period did not meet minimum amounts required by the meal pattern. Specifically, during lunch for grades 9-12, chicken nuggets which contribute 1 oz. whole grain rich oz. per day were served. The daily 2 oz. requirement was not met. This was not a repeat finding from previous cycle and did not contribute toward fiscal action calculations.
