The importance of working together as a team in schools has long-term results. Sergeant Snyder worked as a School Resource Officer at Royal Palm Middle School several years ago. He was recently working in another area of town when he was approached by a young adult. The young adult recognized Sgt. Snyder and began to speak with him while also giving him a hug. He was a former student at Royal Palm 10 years ago and struggled in school. The school regularly held SSAPT meetings with specific goals in mind to address issues in the school. The former student was one of the students that the team decided needed more resources. The student told Sgt. Snyder about how much that extra help had changed his life. He was able to get through school and find a good job. He was also raising his own kids now and was positive about life even though his brother was in prison for choosing a different path in life. He thanked Sgt. Snyder and said the school had changed his life forever. Darcy Estrada was also a large part of that team and is now the Principal of the school.
