Specifically, during breakfast 6 oz eq of Grain was offered and not the weekly 8 oz eq of Grain required. This was not a repeat finding from previous cycle and did not contribute toward fiscal action calculations. Specifically, during lunch the weekly Meat/Meat Alternate requirement was not met, providing 7.25 oz eq of Meat/Meat Alternate and not the 9 oz eq required. This was determined to not be a repeat finding from previous cycle and did not contribute toward fiscal action calculations.

The following product could not be credited towards the meal pattern due to insufficient documentation: Vista Verde Nacho Cheese Sauce. Without sufficient documentation, the reviewer was unable to determine if the quantity requirements were met. This was determined to not be a usda-foods-fact-sheets/. The CN repeat finding from previous cycle and did not contribute towards fiscal action calculations and resulted in termination of performance-based reimbursement (extra 7 cents) until sufficient corrective action is received.
