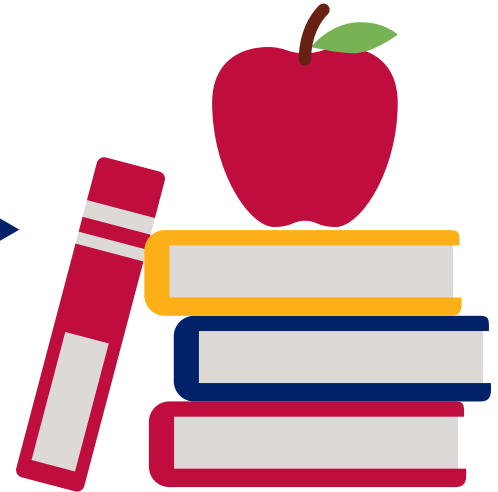




# Integrating Indigenous Perspectives in Social Studies
