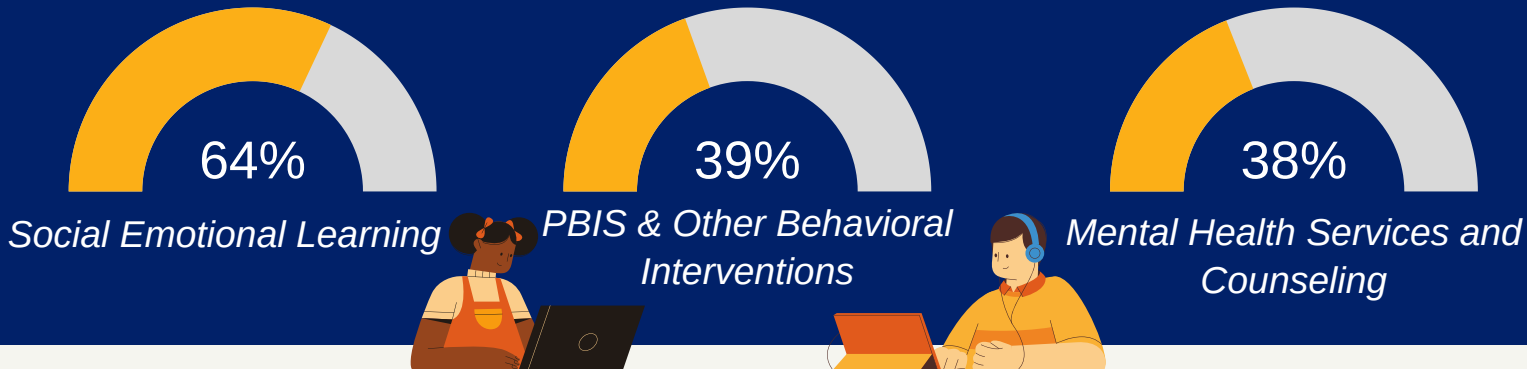


### How are LEAs prioritizing their Title IV-A funding?

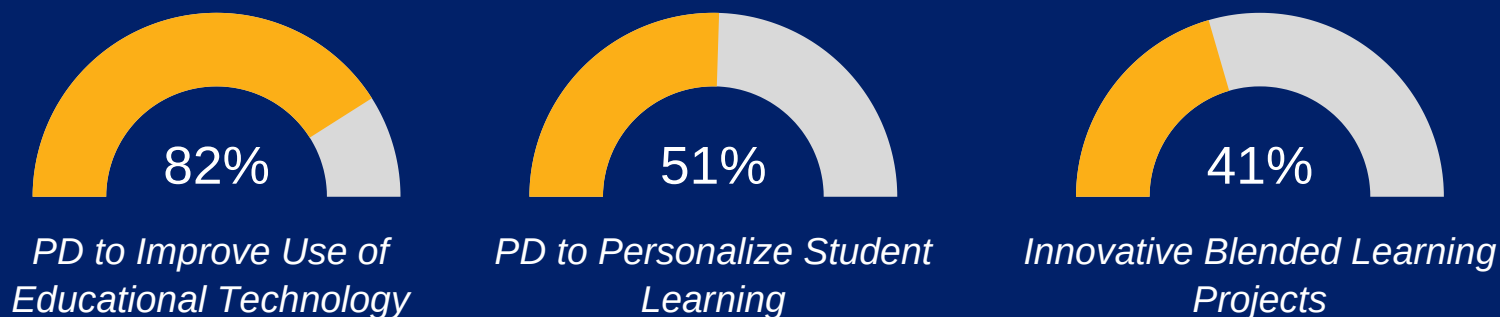
