School and District Data Files: No later than June 23, 2022

## AASA (Arizona's Academic Standards Assessment)

- Electronic reports in PAN: District and School Roster Reports (PDF); Individual Student Reports (PDF); Student Data Files (.txt)
- On-Demand Reporting in PAN: Will include any testing groups set up by April 29 (end of test window); Access for DTCs and STCs; Files available in PDF, CSV, and Excel
- Parent Portal: NEW Beginning 5/25/22; will give parents electronic access to student results via a claim code earlier than hard copies of reports are available
  - Not required but this is a new resource; Letter template to share information with families is coming soon!
