8 The following product could not be credited towards the meal pattern due to insufficient documentation: shredded chicken. Without sufficient documentation, the reviewer was unable to determine if the quantity requirements for meat/meat alternate were met at lunch. This was determined to be a repeat finding attributed to supply chain disruptions and therefore did not contribute toward fiscal action calculations per USDA's COVID-19: Child Nutrition Response #100.

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## **Resource Management**

Non-reimbursable meals served to students free of charge are not accurately tracked. Additionally, the cost of providing non-reimbursable meals was not covered using non-Federal funds.

Discussed that non-reimbursable meals provided to students free of charge must be accurately tracked to ensure that the nonprofit school food service account is reimbursed for the costs of providing these meals using non-Federal funds. Referred to SP 23-2017, Unpaid Meal Charges: Guidance and Q&A, Question 20.

10 Meals served to teachers, administrators, custodians, and other adults were not priced meal prices which included a per meal further corrective action is required. so that the adult payment in combination with any per-lunch revenues from other sources designated specifically for the support of adult meals (such as State or local fringe benefit or payroll funds, or funding from voluntary agencies) was sufficient to cover the overall cost of the meal.

Discussed ways to determine adult cost analysis or pricing adult meals to reflect the amount of reimbursement received for a free meal plus the per meal value of entitlement and bonus commodities for non-pricing programs. Referred to HNS 27-2021 Guidance for Adult Meal Pricing in School Year 2021-2022 (SY 22).

11 The Revenue Ratio (proportion of total revenue from the sale of nonprogram foods to the total revenue of the school food service account) was not equal to or greater than the Food Cost Ratio (proportion of total food costs associated with obtaining nonprogram foods to the total costs associated with obtaining program and nonprogram foods from the account).
