1	Meal count totals by category for the month of review at Casa Grande Middle School were not correctly combined and recorded. This was deemed a non-systemic error and did not contribute toward fiscal action calculations.	Discussed how current system allowed for this to happen and potential changes that could be made to ensure it doesn't continue.	<i>Please provide a written description of changes to the system that have been implemented to ensure that meal count consolidations will provide an accurate count by eligibility category.</i>

2	Daily and weekly vegetable quantities observed at lunch during the review period at Evergreen Elementary did not meet minimum amounts required by the meal pattern. This is not a repeat finding and did not contribute toward fiscal action calculations.	Discussed how current system allowed for this to happen and potential changes that could be made to ensure it doesn't continue. Discussed with cafeteria staff how to properly identify and count reimbursable meals, as well as procedures if a student does not select a reimbursable meal.
