## **Menu Planning**

1 Quantities observed during the review period did not meet minimum amounts required by the meal pattern during breakfast. Specifically, the fruit quantity was not met on 1 day, which also caused the weekly fruit quantity not to be met. This was not a repeat finding from cycle two and did not contribute towards fiscal action calculations.

Only 3/4 cup of fruit was served one day at breakfast instead of the required 1 cup, which caused the weekly fruit requirement to be short. This was due to the SFA serving the SFSP Meal Pattern instead of the SBP Meal Pattern. SFA is aware of meal pattern requirements, they just implemented the incorrect meal pattern due to confusion with operating the summer program. Please note that repeated violations involving food quantities may result in fiscal action and/or termination of performance-based

2 Fluid milk was not available in at least two varieties for breakfast and lunch during the review period. This was not a repeat finding from cycle two and did not contribute towards fiscal action calculations.

This error was due to the SFA serving the SFSP Meal Pattern instead of the NSLP/SBP Meal Pattern. SFA is aware of meal pattern requirements, they just implemented the incorrect meal pattern due to confusion with operating the summer program. Allowable milk varieties are fatfree unflavored, fat-free flavored and 1% unflavored. Please note that repeated violations involving food quantities may result in fiscal action and/or termination of performance-based reimbursement (extra 7 cents).

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Please provide a written description of changes that will be made to ensure that the correct meal pattern will be served. Please also provide written assurance that if SSO is operated in the future the NSLP/SBP meal pattern will be utilized.

3 Quantities observed during the review period did not meet minimum amounts required by the meal pattern during lunch. Specifically, the daily vegetable quantity was not met, which also caused the weekly vegetable quantity not to be met. This was a repeat finding from cycle two and contributed towards fiscal action calculations.

Only 1/2 cup of vegetables were served each day instead of the required 3/4 cup, which caused the weekly vegetable requirement to be short. This error was due to the SFA serving the SFSP Meal Pattern instead of the NSLP Meal Pattern. SFA is aware of meal pattern requirements, they just implemented the incorrect meal pattern due to confusion with operating the summer program.
