
# ADE/CTE Strategic Plan and Perkins V Revisions

#### **CTE Opportunity Gap Analysis Project**

#### Purpose:

Examine CTE enrollment data to identify and address opportunity gaps.

Identify and prioritize root causes, explore evidencebased intervention strategies, and propose specific action steps to address these gaps.

Launch data-driven discussion within local communities to provide meaningful action to enhance access to CTE opportunities for each learner.

#### Objectives of the project:

Discuss why equity is important in CTE and understand common equity and access challenges in CTE.

Draw on practical evidence-based strategies to address root causes and barriers to access.



### **Important Dates**

The original deadline of July 31 has been extended!

#### August 19, 2022

- CTE Data Portal will close for FY 2022 (except Credentials)
  - 2022 Coherent Sequence closes
  - 2022 Enrollment reporting closes
  - 2021 Placement Survey closes

#### September 2022

- Participants/Concentrators are generated by the system.
- Final funding is calculated and posted.
- Performance measures are calculated and posted.



# Enrollment reporting & Placement Survey are open for **corrections**.

Preliminary funding has been calculated and is available in the CTE Data Portal.

Preliminary list of participants and concentrators has been created and is available in CTE Data Portal.

PC records are created at the school that last gave the student credit in the program, even if student is no longer enrolled at that school.

All finalized enrollment and placement surveys are due by August 19, 2022.



# New Enrollment Status Codes in FY22 Participants/Concentrators

AzEDS Exit Codes ("leave codes") have been replaced with an "Enrollment Status" code:

Code	Students
GR	Students have <b>graduated</b> from high school – concentrators qualify for Placement Survey.
LS	Students have <b>left secondary</b> education in Arizona (other than graduates) & concentrators still qualify for Placement Survey.
NE	Students are <b>no longer enrolled</b> in secondary education in Arizona & concentrators do not qualify for Placement Survey.
SE	Students are <b>still enrolled</b> in secondary education in Arizona.
SU	Student's status is unknown



#### **Data Verification Checklist**

# New formula for CTE State Priority grant will be applied to FY 2022 enrollment.

FY 2023 CTE State Priority grant will use new formula for enrollment-based portion of allocation (75%).

Determination of related placement-based portion of allocation will remain the same and will be based on 2021 placement survey.

It is not recommended to compare your funding to last year's since the formula has changed.



- Report shows the total student headcount for each course in your district, broken down by where the course is taught.
- Report includes ALL courses, including those that are ineligible for funding.
- Nothing in this report affects your district's funding and it is dependent on enrollment reported in the CTE Data Portal.




### District Enrollment Funding Report

- Report shows total student count for each eligible course for your entire district.
- Eligible headcount is multiplied by the program's weight to determine "Eligible weighted count".
- Each course's proportion of the eligible weighted count for the state determines the proportion of funding generated by the course.



### Courses Ineligible for Funding Report

- Report shows class information for each class that is not eligible for funding.
- Report does **not** include a "lost" dollar amount.
- Reasons a class may be ineligible:
  - Teacher improperly certified
  - No concentrators within 4 years of program inception
  - No placements within 4 years of program inception
- Submit exemption requests when appropriate by August 19, 2022.



#### **Related Placements**

- Placements must be aligned to the technical skills of the student's CTE program to be considered "related".
- Utilizing professional skills and not the technical skills should not be considered related placement.
- Districts should verify placement data is accurate before submitting.
- Districts should maintain some form of documentation of how they obtained their placement information for each record (contact with student, parent, etc.).

# Helpful Tips for New Directors

#### and experienced directors too

- Bookmark and check the ADE-CTE website regularly for helpful resources.
- Read/review all of the resources/information already posted on the ADE-CTE website.
- Attend in-person CTE Data Portal trainings in your region this Fall.
- Work on your enrollment reports early on to avoid roadblocks closer to the deadline – especially if you need to involve district IT/SIS staff.
- Utilize the error reports when uploading.



# Helpful Tips for New Directors

#### and experienced directors too

- Utilize the full data reporting window (9 months)
- Spread out data reporting responsibilities and tackle tasks one at a time.
- See "Local Responsibilities by Month" handout.





# Eligibility Policy for Students to Take and Retake the Technical Skills Assessment

- In a traditional or block schedule a student should take the test when completing
  two courses worth one credit each in a single CTE program or when completing three
  courses worth one credit each in a single CTE program. A student can only take the test
  one time.
- If a district has added courses to a program beyond the state's designated course sequence in a single CTE program, it will be the district's decision as to when the student will take the test, that is, after the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, or 4<sup>th</sup> course. A student can only take the test one time.
- If a student fails the test and retakes the course or takes an additional course in a single CTE program, the student can retake the test in the next school year prior to graduation through special arrangements with ADE/CTE. The last test score counts.
- If an IEP or 504 plan states that the student can take the test more than one time, the student can retake the test in the current or next school year prior to graduation through special arrangements with ADE/CTE. The last test score counts.





- Purchase capital at beginning of school year
- Purchase supply items at beginning of school year
- Work with your Business Manager to ensure regular submission of reimbursement requests
- Read History Log communications from your Grant Program Specialists
- Focus on FY2023 CLNA and Measurable Objectives goals / targets
- Provide narrative details when submitting your grant revisions
- Adhere to grant specific deadlines

## **Things That May Affect Your Grants**

- Ordering equipment / supplies not listed in grant
- Procrastination in purchasing = irregularity in reimbursement request submissions
- Limited / vague information in budget narratives when submitting grant revisions
- Global Holds prevent your grants from being approved. Resolve Global Holds with GME as soon as possible
- \*\*Contact GPS for review prior to submission if you are unsure about any of your revisions
