Static File Inquires and Data Correction Windows

Static File v1 is now available for schools and districts through ADEConnect. There will be two more releases of the static file. Each release serves a unique and distinct purpose. Please be sure to review The Grader, and any communication from Achieve, for announcements regarding these files and to not miss important dates. Please reach out to <u>Achieve@azed.gov</u> should you have any questions.

1. Static File Version 1 – Now available – This file is the enrollment, program, and FAY validation.

a. The following items detail what should be checked:

i. The file should be carefully reviewed to ensure all students that a school expects to be included, based on enrollment dates, and none are missing from the file.

ii. The file should be carefully reviewed to ensure program enrollment is correct:



1. Special Education is dependent upon October 1 status

2. Income Eligibility is updated throughout the school year

3. English Learner is dependent upon having an identified EL need

iii. FAY should be reviewed for accuracy

1. Students are considered FAY if enrolled within the first ten calendar days and continuously enrolled through Monday, May 3. FAY status is used for ELA and Math Assessments and all calculations (except for EL, chronic absenteeism, and graduation)

2. Students are considered AZELLA FAY if enrolled within the first ten days of the calendar year and continuously enrolled until the last day of the original EL testing window. AZELLA FAY is used for EL calculations.

b. All corrections to the file must be completed by **July 15** through a school/district/charter holder SIS to be accurately recorded and be reflected in future releases

2. Static File Version 2 – August– This file will include any student's aligned assessment and growth data, and students who may have had corrections made in the school's SIS.

a. The following items detail what should be checked:

i. Only students that had valid assessments and were not left in any of the assessment correction applications will have assessments aligned to the student

ii. Only students that had a valid assessment from 2021 and were not left in any of the assessment correction applications will have previous assessments included

iii. Only students with assessments from i and ii will receive growth in the following grades/subjects:

Integrity Error Guide

Accountability has created a document to help schools troubleshoot Accountabilityrelated integrity errors, such as errors with pupil withdrawals or membership. The document includes error code numbers, the code descriptions, and troubleshooting for each code. Schools should keep in mind that integrity failures result in students not appearing in important Accountability related reports and documents, including the A-F static file. Self-Report Applications

The A-F Self Reporting Data application opened on ADEConnect on May 3rd, 2022 in order for schools to submit their self-reported data components (CCRI, Credits Earned, and On-Track to Graduate). The application will close on **July 29th**, **2022 at the end of the business day**. After this deadline, schools will no longer be able to submit data for the 2021-2022 school year. Accountability Update

April 22, 2022, the Arizona State Board of Education voted on LEA Letter Grades for the 2022-2023 school year. The LEA Letter Grades will be released Fall of 2023 based on data from the 2022-2023 school year. The Accountability Team will assist schools using this year's data to plan for the next fiscal year. The letter grades will be based on a straight GPA for an LEA based on their schools receiving two or more grades. One school LEAs will receive the same letter grade as their school. August 2022	 <u>Special Note: Due to performance level setting and the</u> <u>availability of scores, the 2nd and 3rd version of the static file</u> <u>may need to be combined.</u> Early August (Release V2) – This file will contain assessment results, assessment corrections submitted by July 30. This file needs to be reviewed for any issues regarding assessments. Late August (Release V3) – The file will contain growth data Late August: School-level aggregated data available in ADEConnect
September 2022	 September/October (Release V4) – This is the final version that will contain all updated information.
October 2022	 October 1 reporting date for ADE programs and schools
